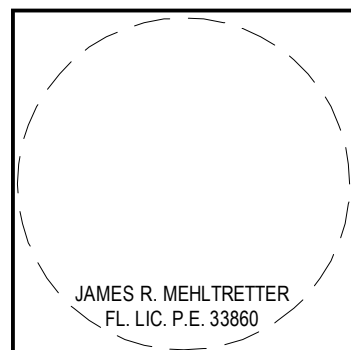

LOCATOR MAP



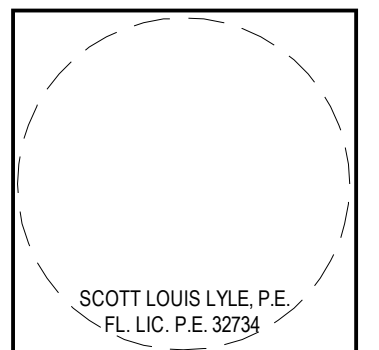

Construction

Optics

DISTRIBUTION: Dedicated optical cavities for the array of 20 individual LEDs maximizes the efficiency and control of the distribution out of each module. Four or six total optical modules are optimally aimed to maximize

light collection and directional distribution onto the application area. Each reflector is specifically manufactured via injection molding and coated with a highly reflective optical coating via vacuum-metalization. Precisely engineered reflectors are coupled to the board media and sealed to an optically optimized premium glass lens. LEDs: Greater than 90% lumen maintenance expected at 60,000 hours per TM-21. Electrical

DRIVER: LED drivers are potted and seal optical enclosure to housing and prolonged life. Standard drivers feature electronic universal voltage (120-277V/50-60Hz), greater than 0.8 power factor, less than 20% harmonic distortion and feature ambient temperature range of +40°C (104°F) down to minimum starting temperature of -40°C (22°F). Two standard drive currents are available (350mA or 700mA). Shipped standard with our proprietary circuit module designed to withstand 10kV of transient line surge. Housing is finished in super TGIC polyester powder coat paint, 2.5 mil nominal thickness for superior protection against fade and wear. 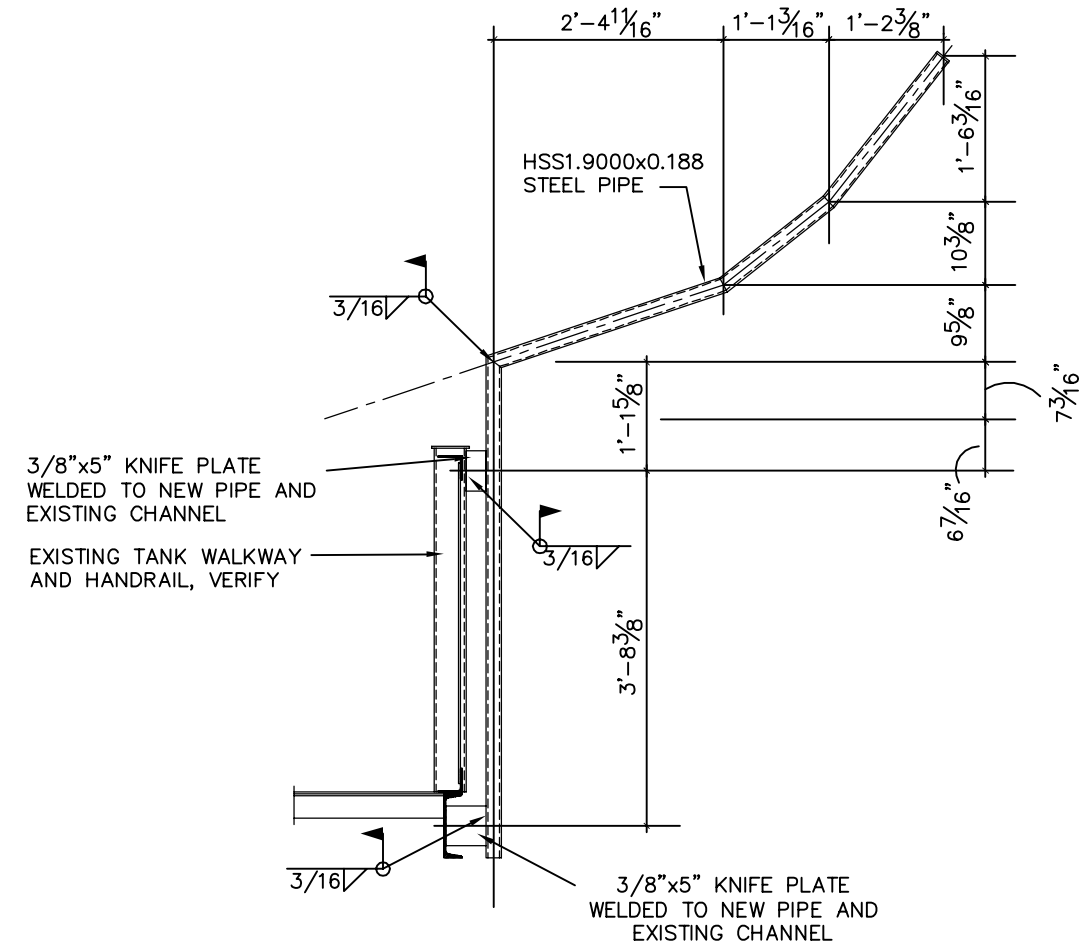

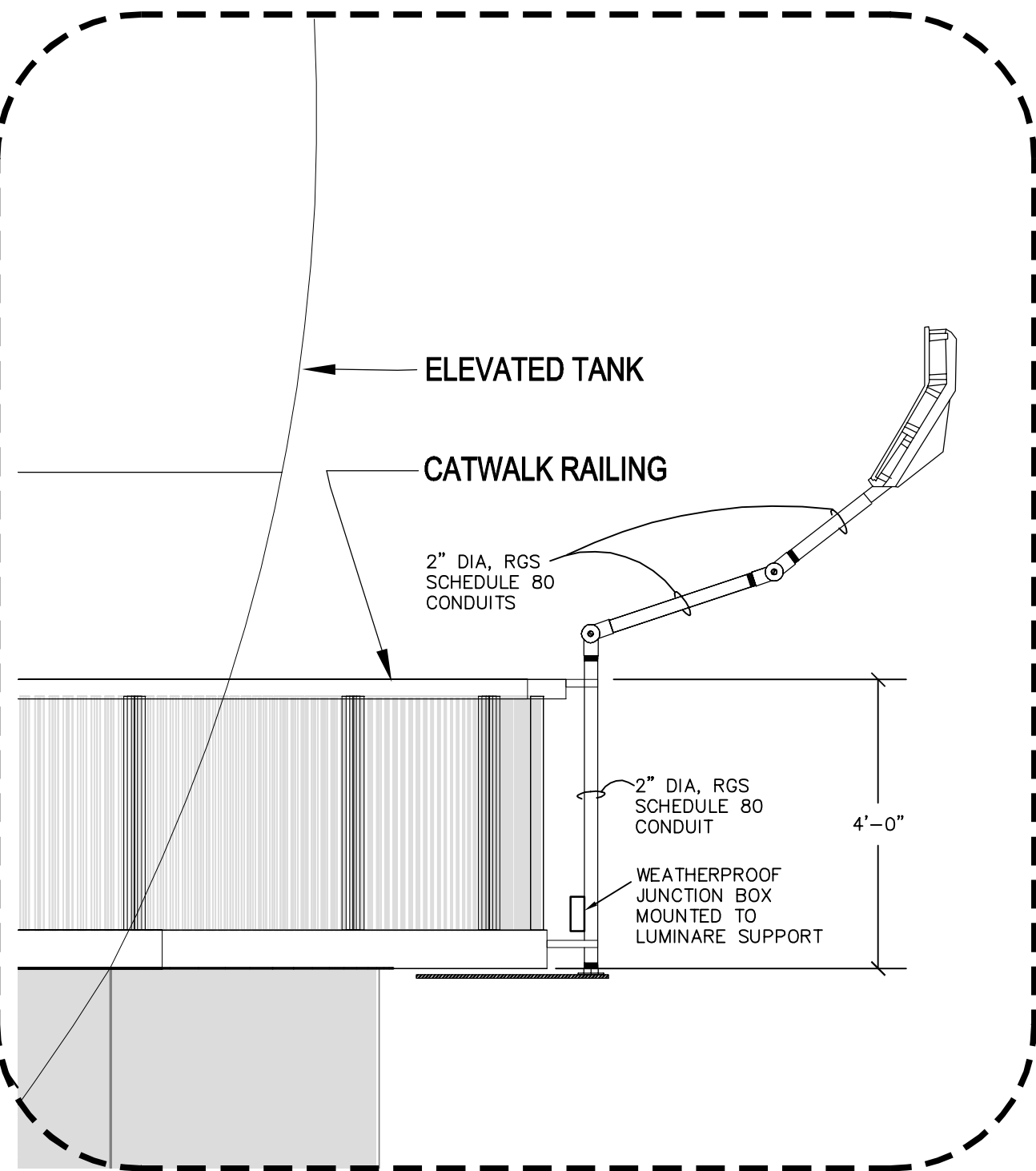
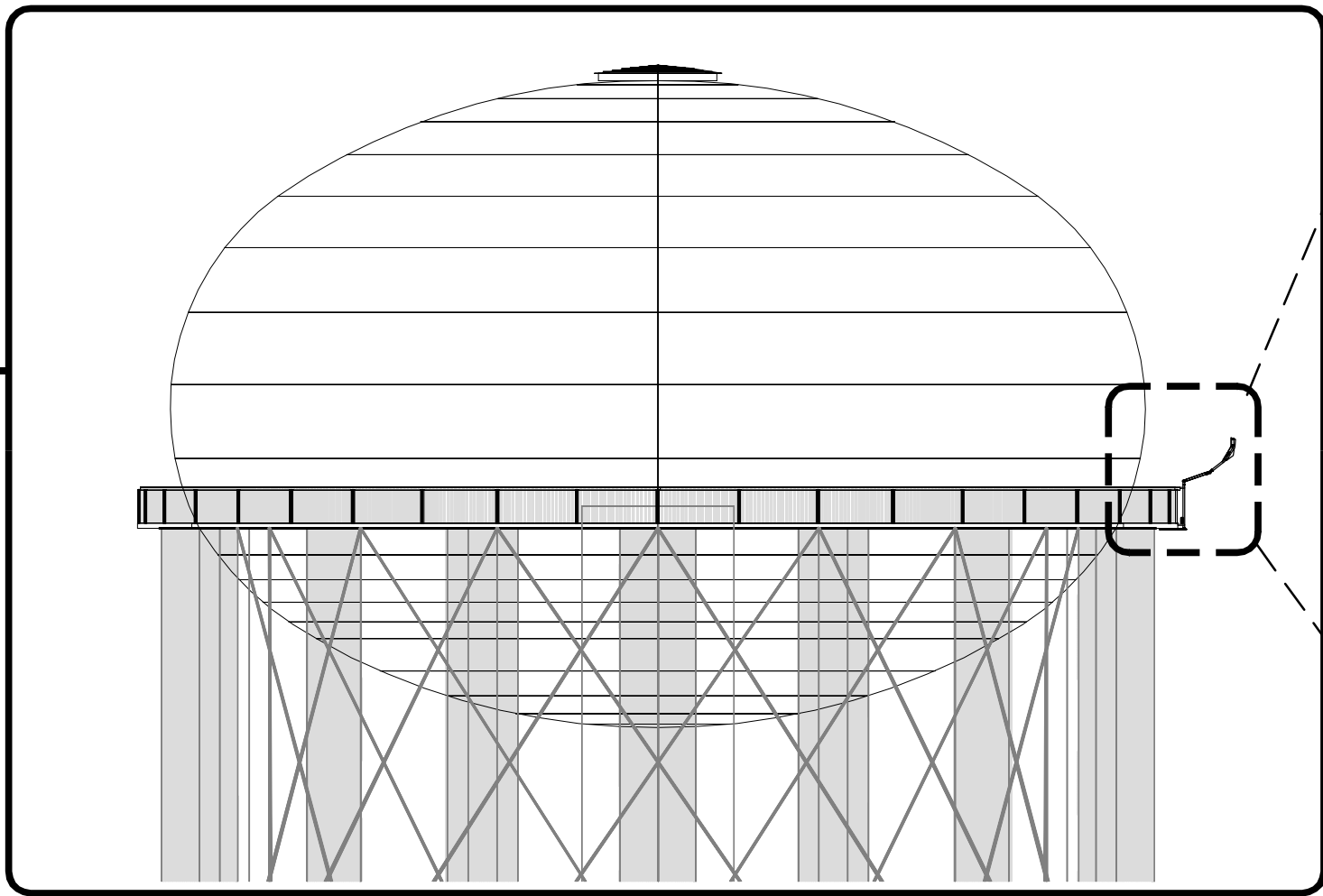
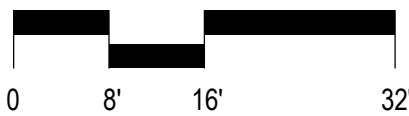
LUMINAIRE MOUNTING DETAIL

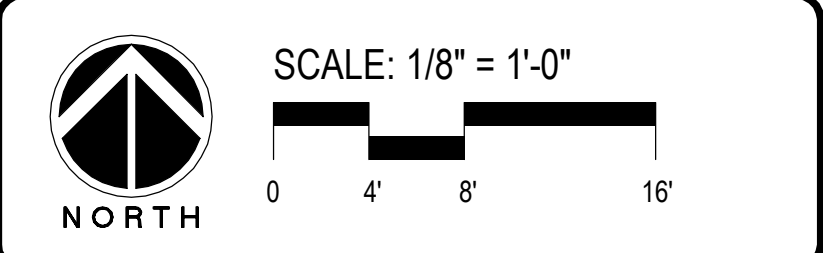
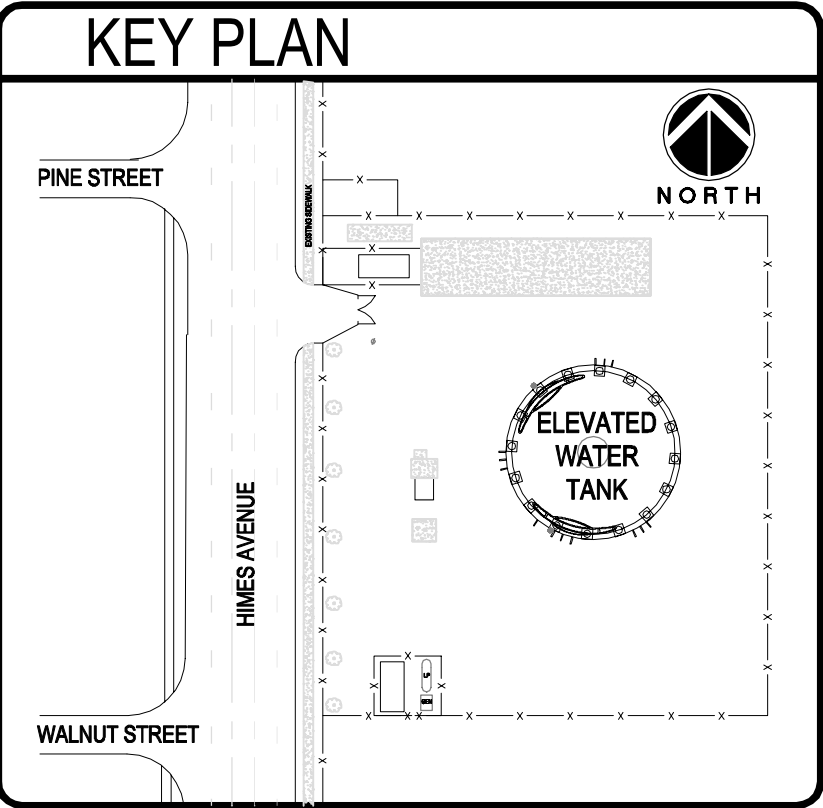
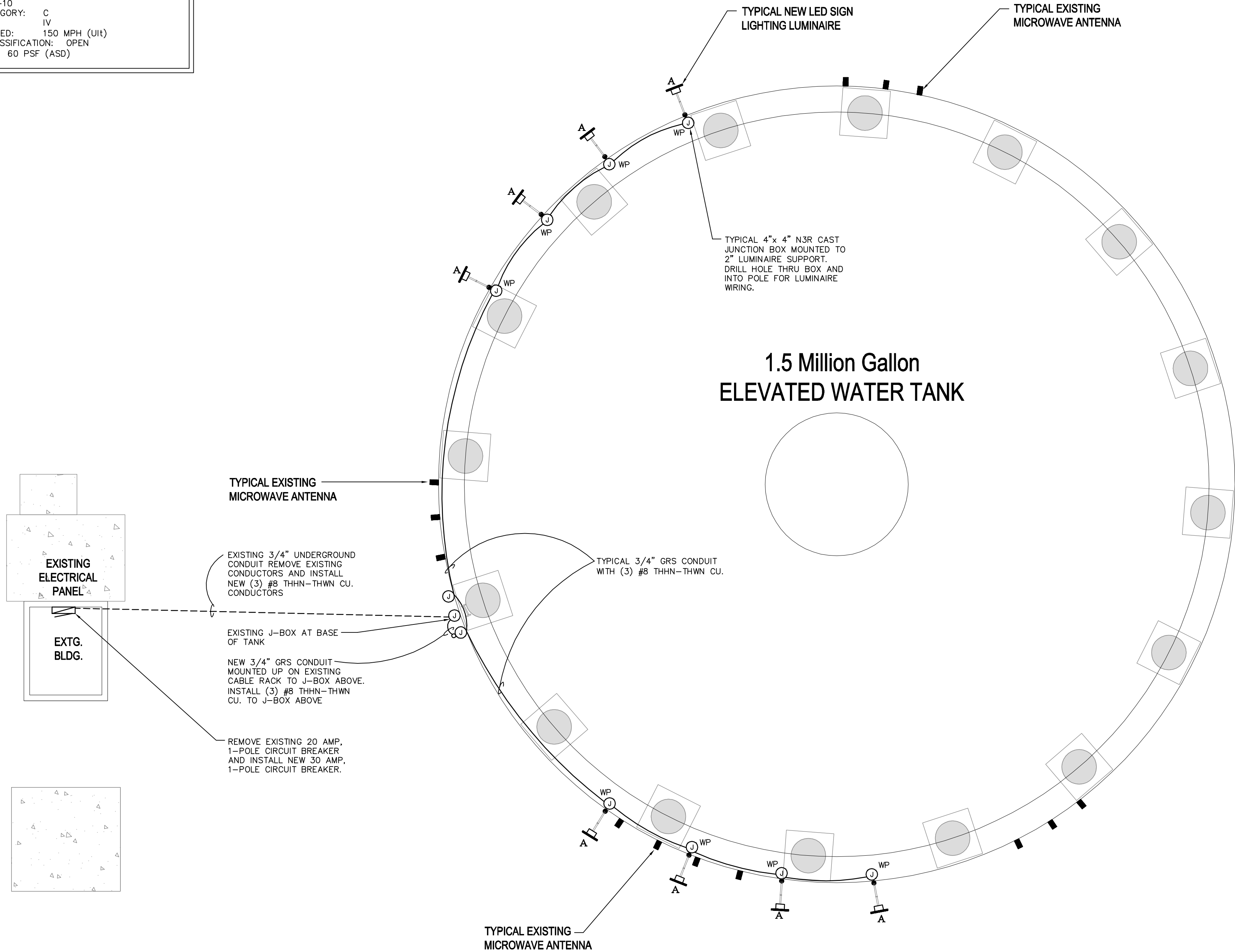
WEST TAMPA WATER TANK
