30th Street Outfall

Estimated cost: \$600K

Project Description:

Stormwater has acquired the property on the east side of the outfall. The intent is to enlarge the discharge channel and, if necessary construct a larger outfall structure to accommodate future pipes.

Justification:

Existing 60-inch diameter stormwater pipe outfalls to Hillsborough River at 30th Street, causing continual erosion of adjoining properties. City crews have installed rip-rap to fortify the banks, but erosion has persisted.

Related Issues:

Several stormwater pumping stations utilize the existing outfall pipe and expanding the channel will allow for the extension of force mains directly to the river.
