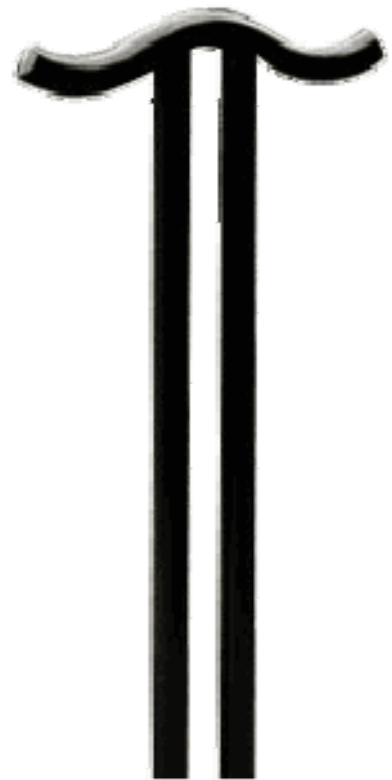

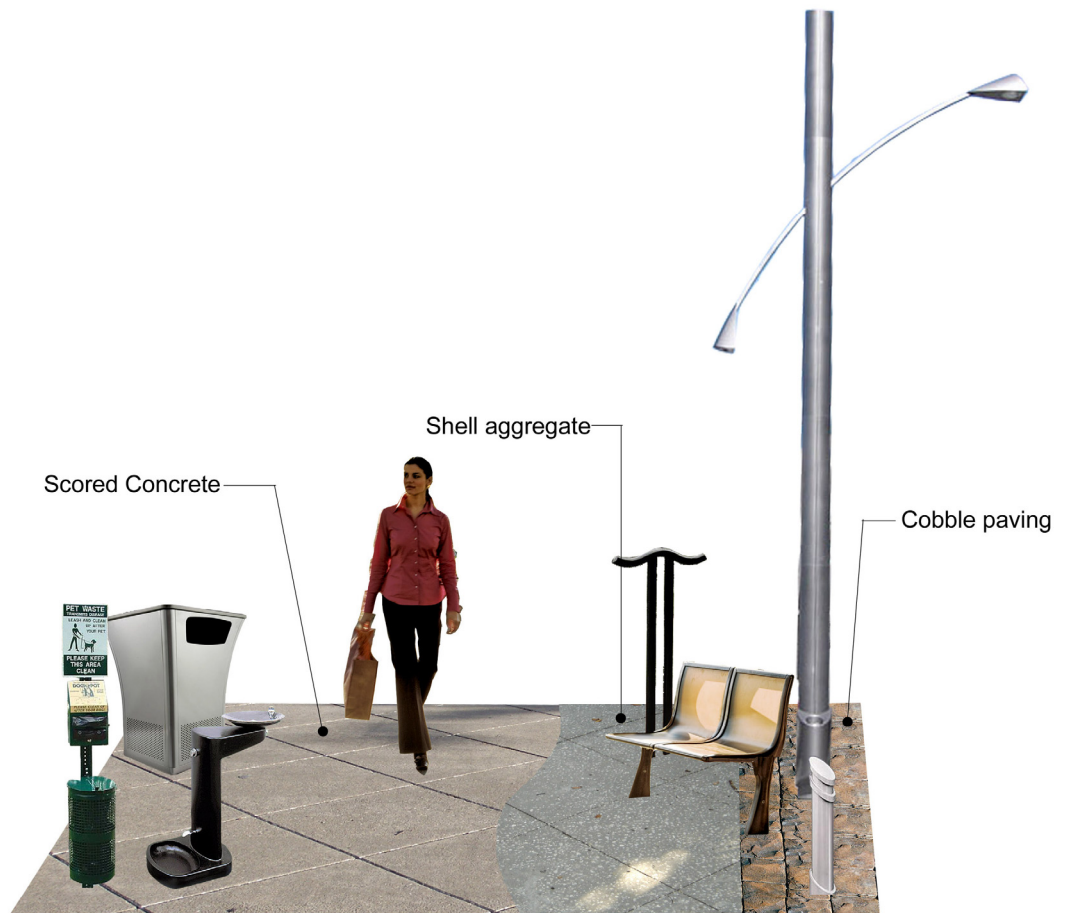

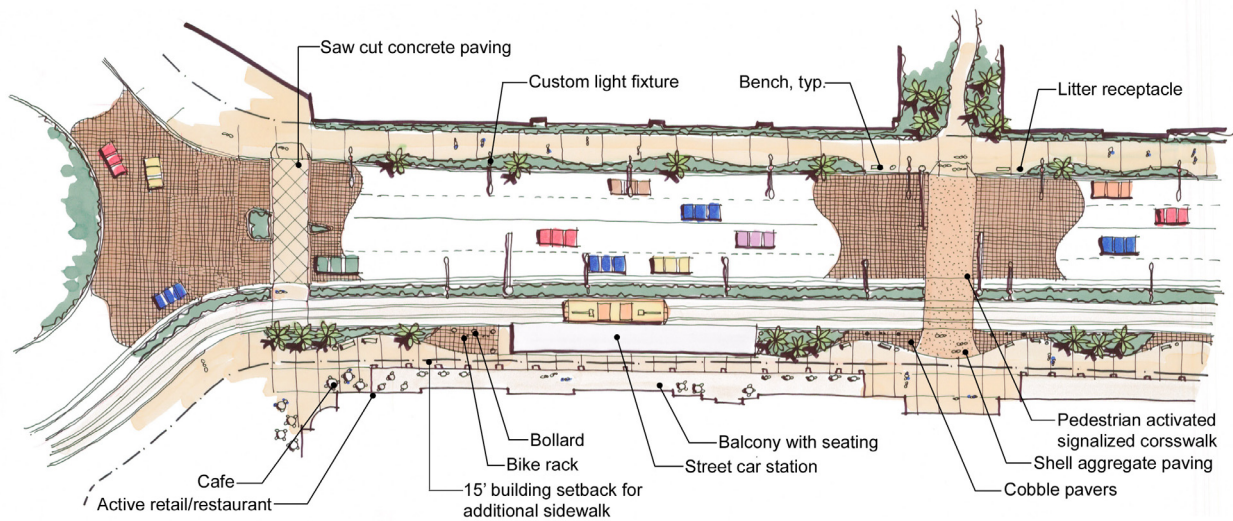

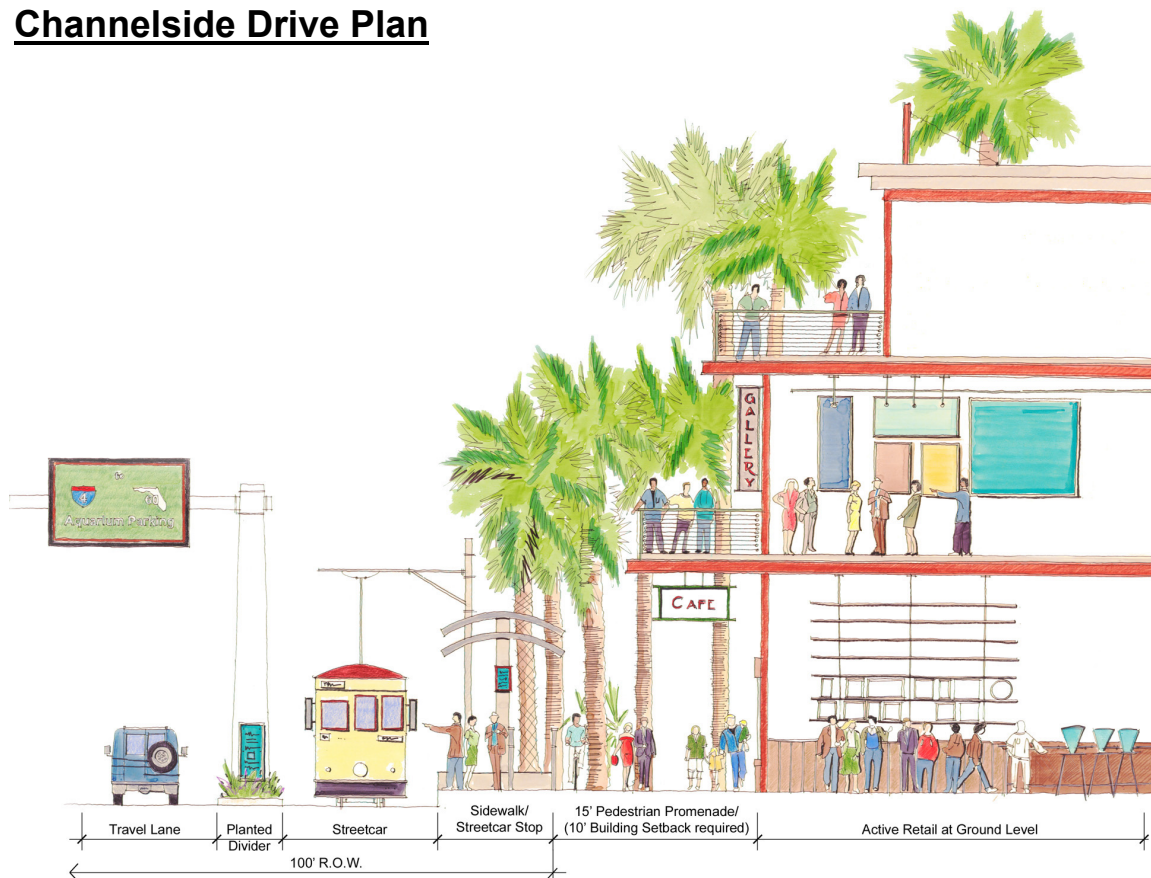

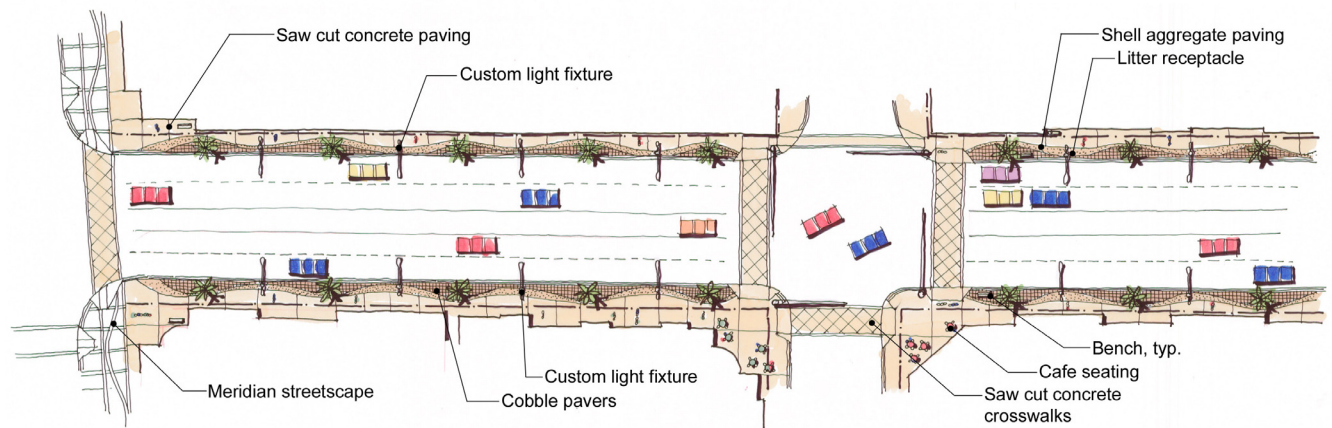

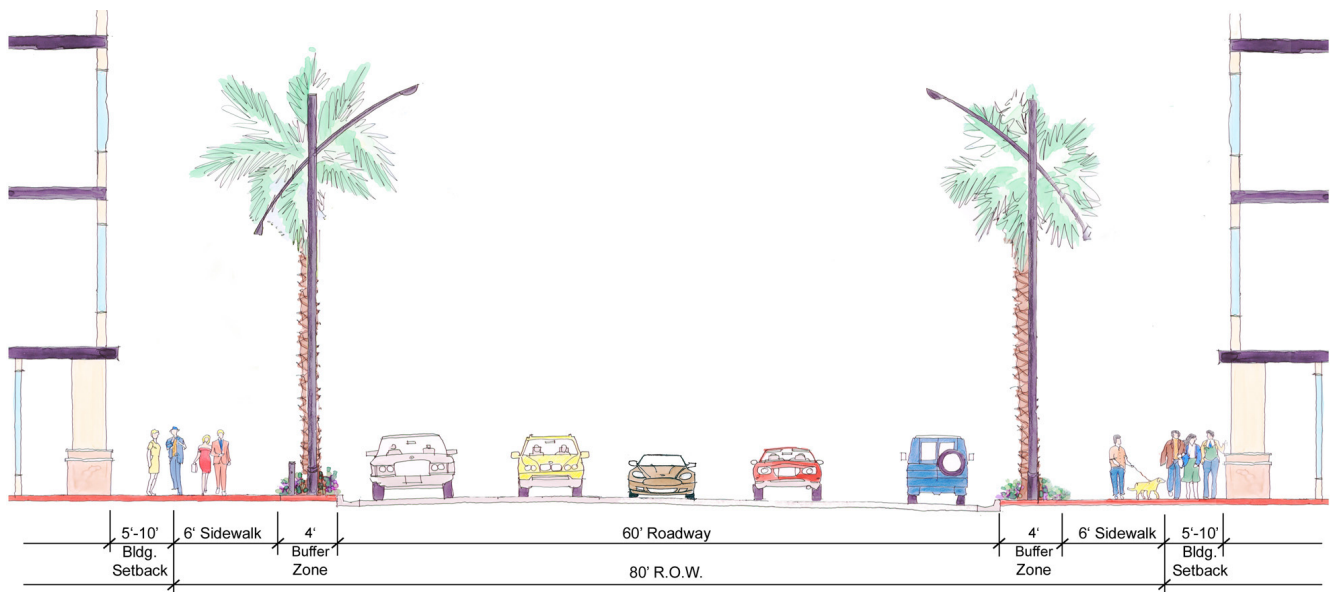
Channelside Drive Plan



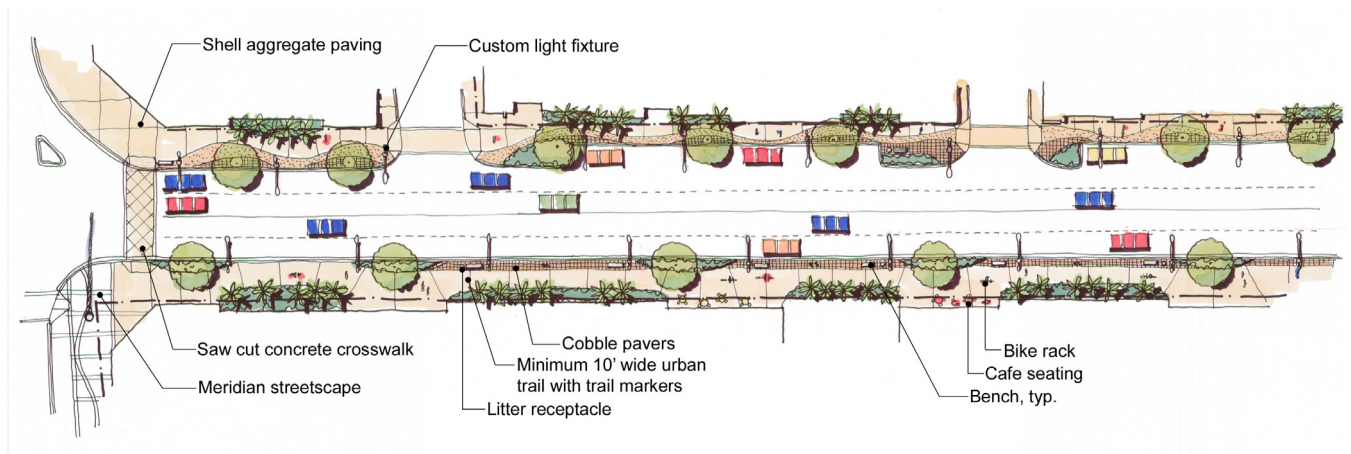
Channelside Drive Section – 100' R.O.W.



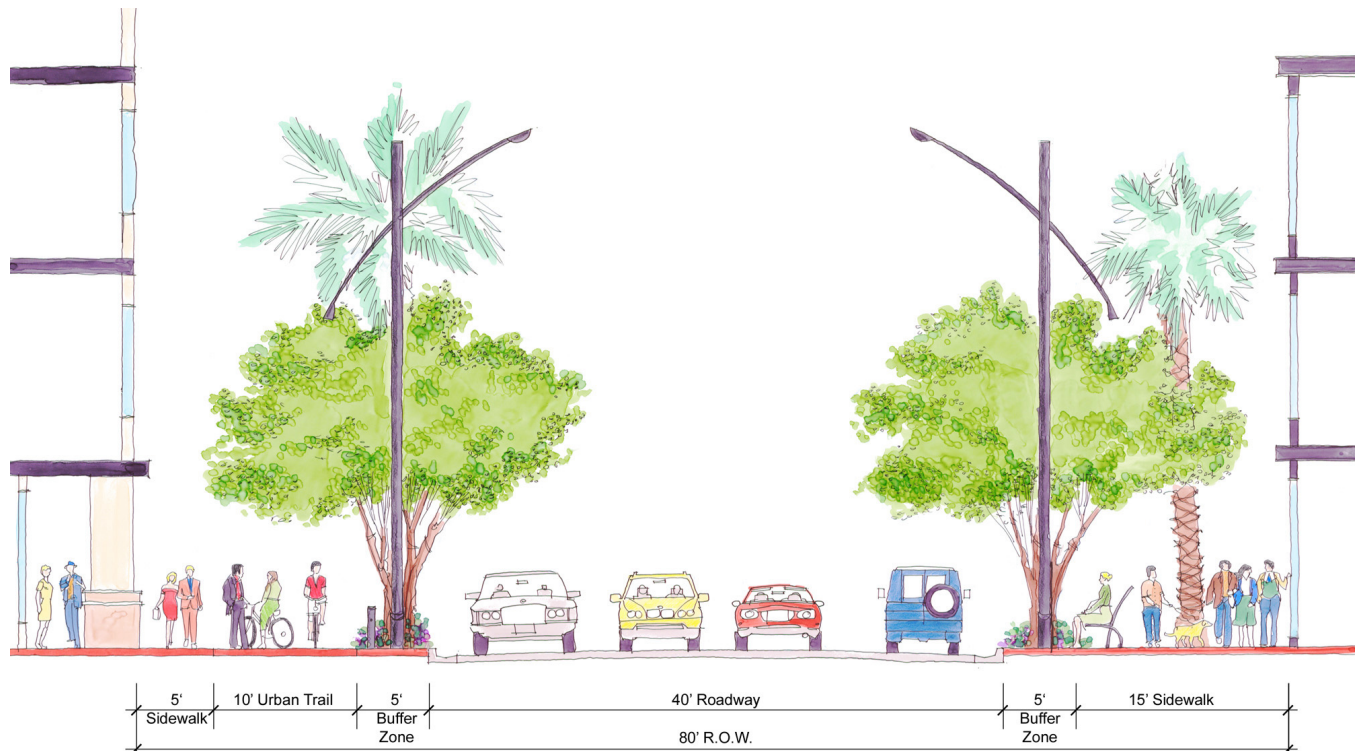
Kennedy Boulevard Plan



Kennedy Boulevard Section – 80' R.O.W.

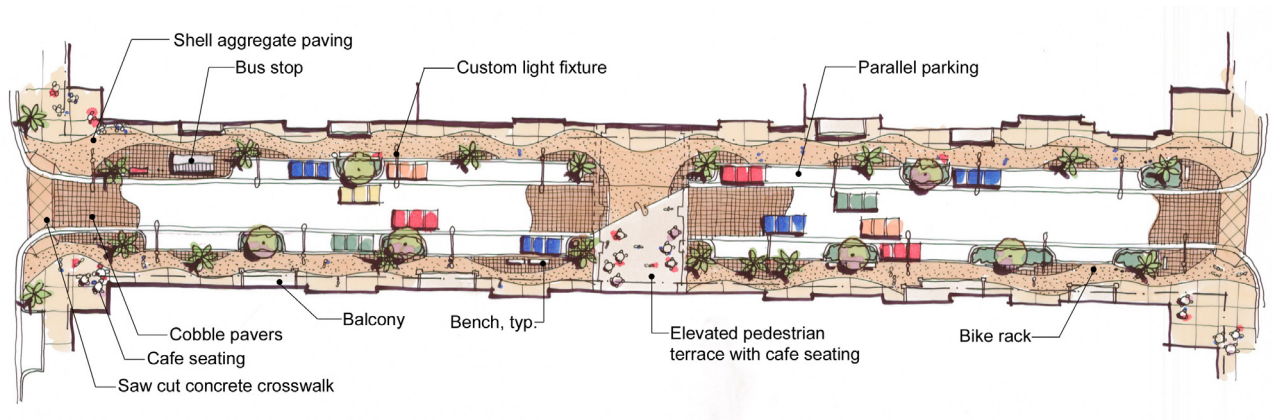


Twiggs Street Plan

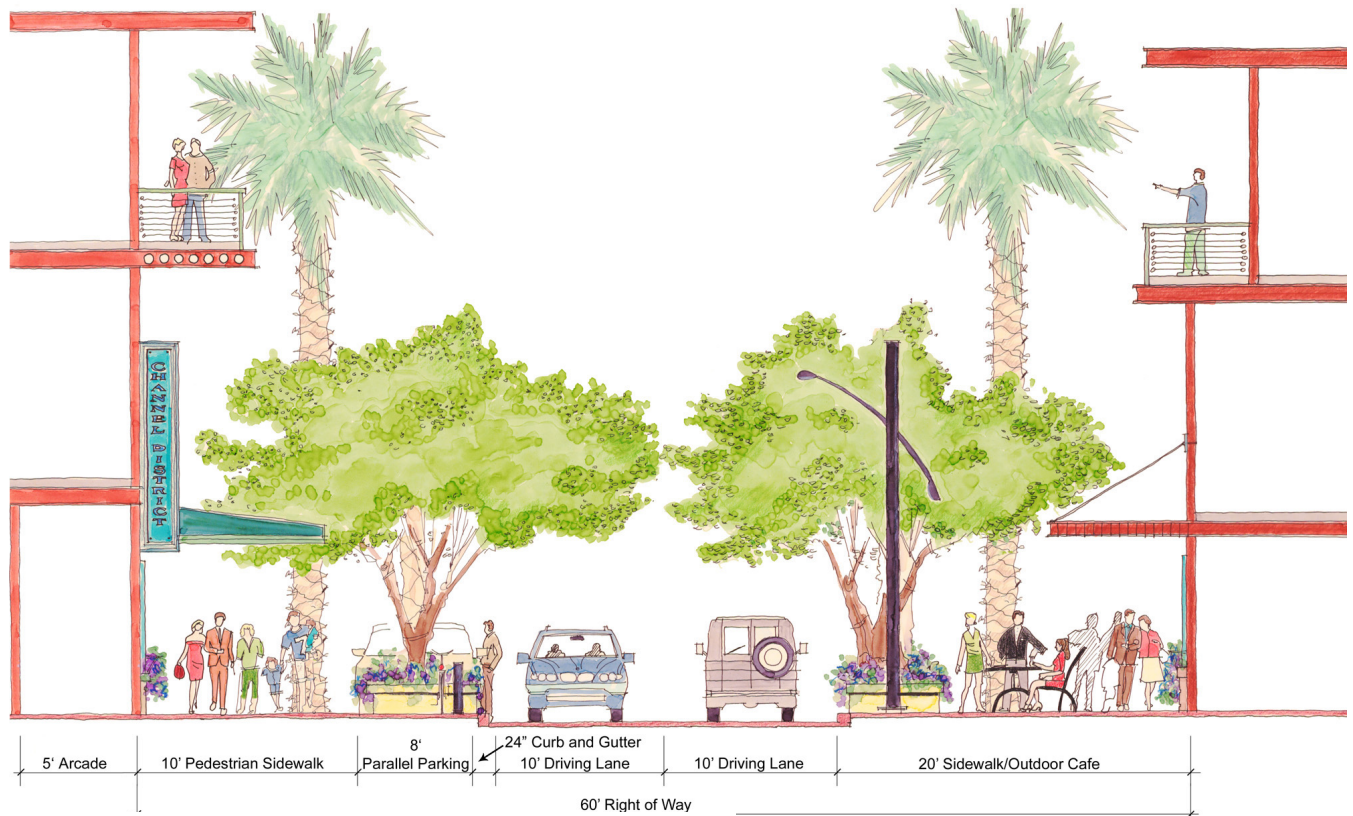


Twiggs Street Section – 80' R.O.W.





Interior Street Plan



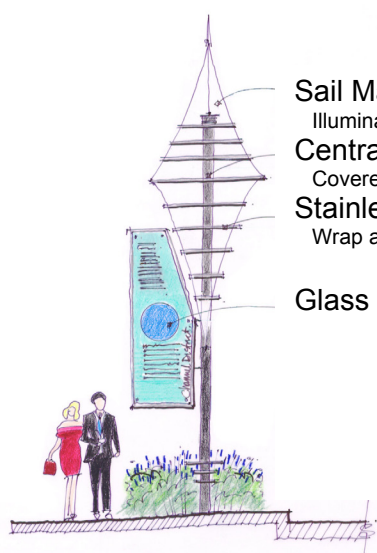
Interior Street Section – 60' R.O.W.



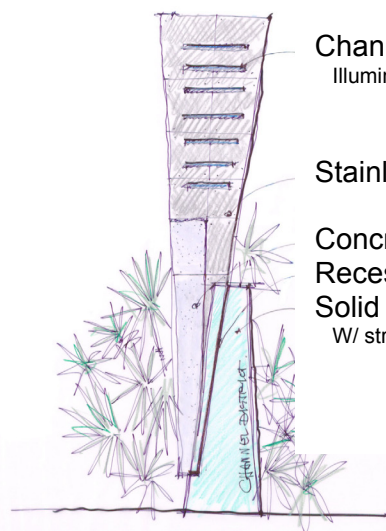


The gateway concepts displayed below focus on the evolution of the Channel District. Different materials such as metals, light, water, and glass represent each stage of the District's evolution.

The gateway elements shown are conceptual. The final gateway design could be determined through a design competition among local artists.

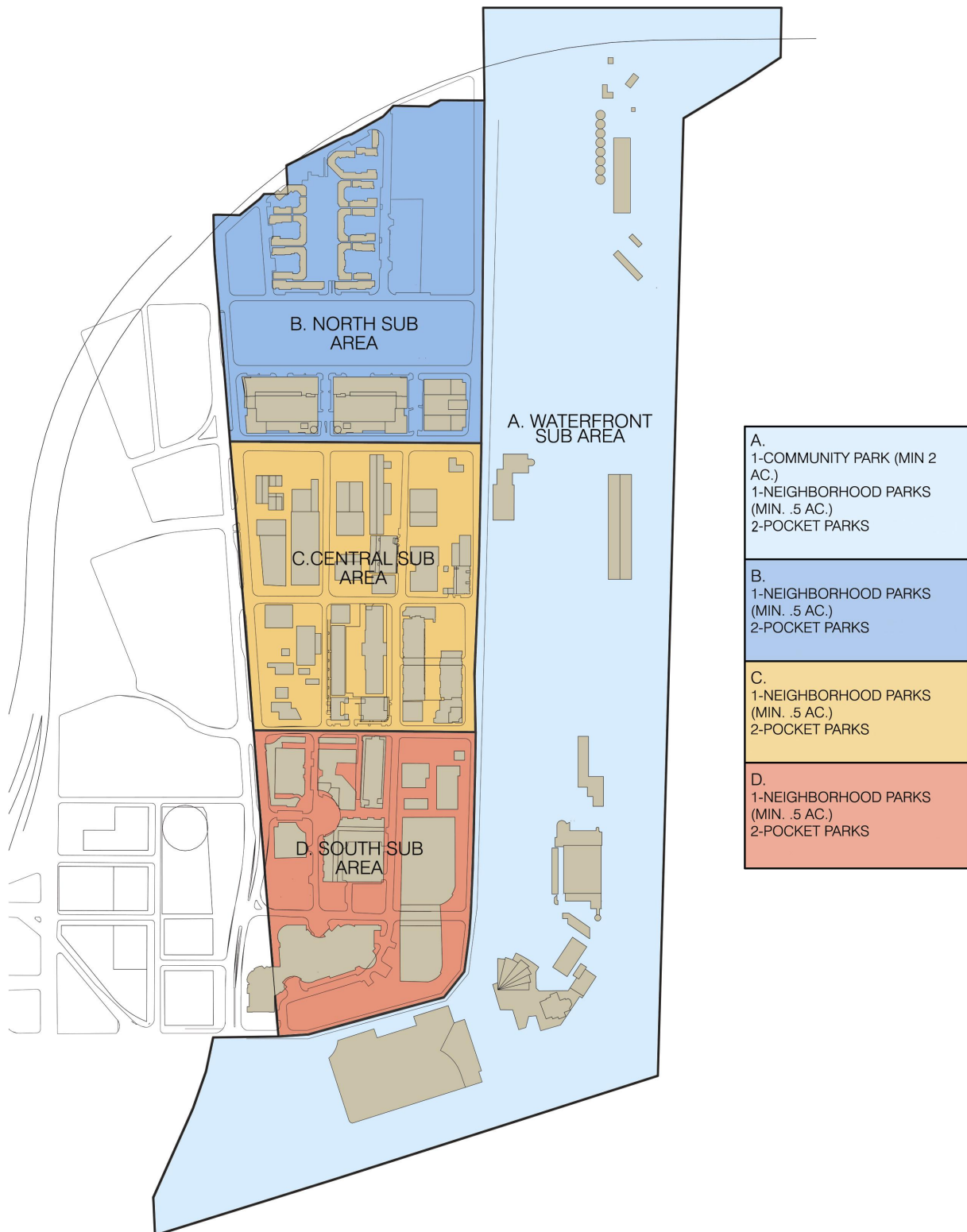


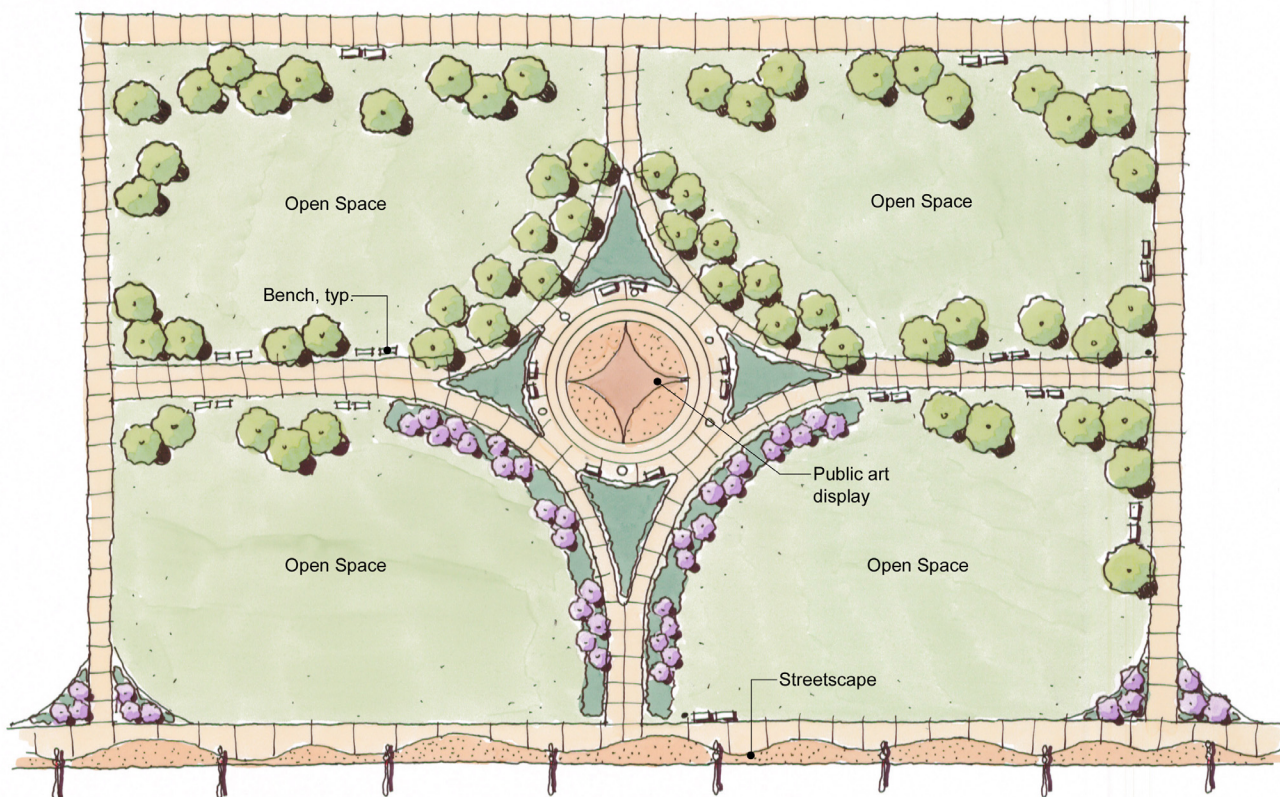
- Sail Material**

- Glass Panel**



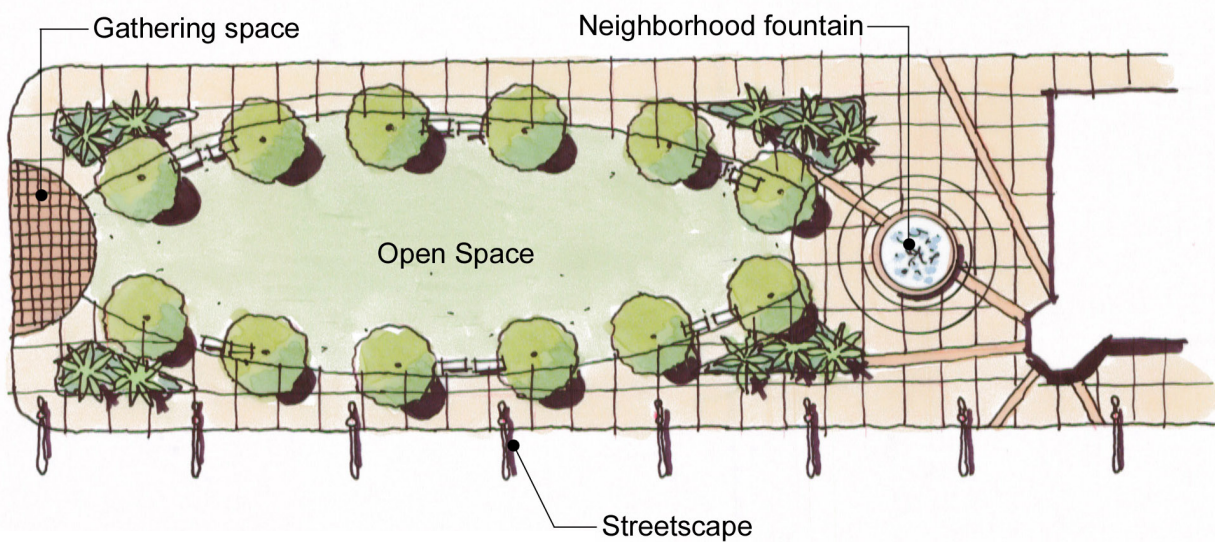
- Channels of Light**

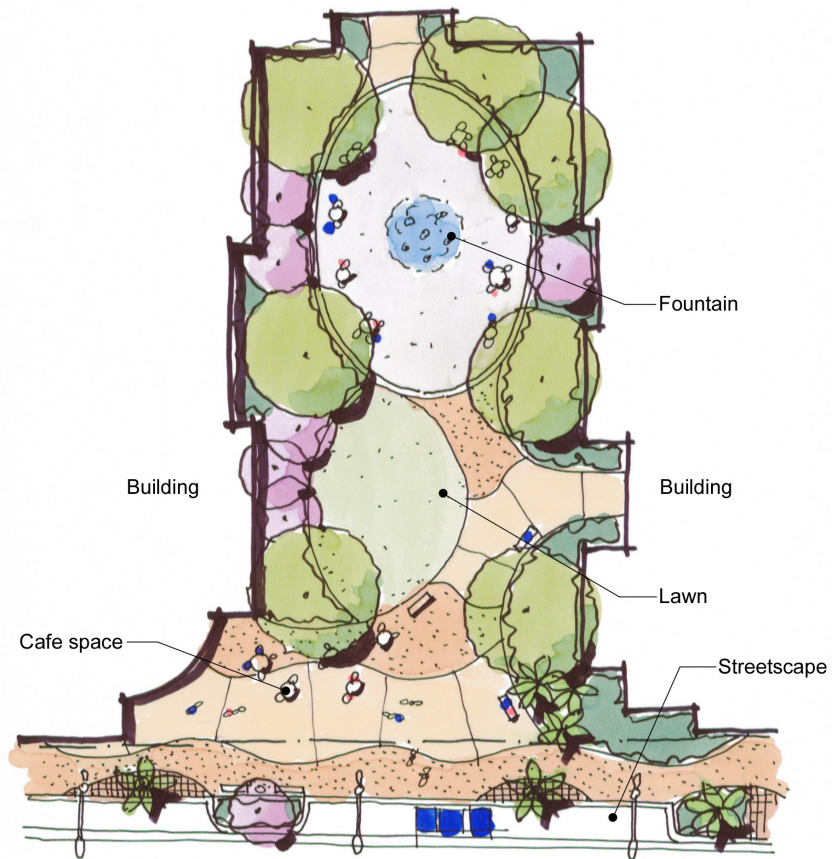
