Streetscape and Beautification Plan



COMMUNITY MEETING:

Please plan on attending the City of Tampa's Drew Park Streetscape and Beautification Master Plan Community Meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to introduce the Drew Park Streetscape and Beautification Plan project to the community and for Drew Park stakeholders to share their ideas and vision for the area prior to the consultants creating design concepts. Bayside Engineering and David Conner and Associates have been retained by the City as consultants for this project. The consultants will make a brief presentation of their analysis of the Drew Park Community Redevelopment Area (CRA). The meeting will then be opened up for comments from the community. Community members will be encouraged to contribute their thoughts and concerns for consideration as part of the design process.

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The Streetscape and Beautification Master Plan is being developed to improve the aesthetic conditions of the streets and public rights-of-way throughout Drew Park. Features being considered include decorative street lighting, gateway signage, landscaping, and other improvements.

FUTURE MEETINGS:

There will be a second meeting in May for the community to review designs and provide additional input. The third and final community meeting will be held in late summer 2011.
