## **Current Development Highlights April 2010**

- The Tampa Housing Authority was awarded a \$38 million Neighborhood Stabilization Program II grant to fund new infrastructure for the 28-acre, master-planned Encore development.
- The Encore team is working with State officials to attract funding for the redevelopment of Perry Harvey, Sr. Park.
- The March 25th Encore construction job fair drew approximately 4,700 job seekers.
- The Encore groundbreaking is scheduled for May 11th at 10:00 a.m.
- Tampa City Council transmitted a Tampa
   Comprehensive Plan map amendment for 41-acres
   of land north of Encore to the Department of
   Community Affairs for approval. Once adopted, the
   enhanced classifications will better position the
   property for redevelopment.
- The City is utilizing a \$400,000 EPA Brownfields Assessment Grant targeting Central Park and three other CRAs to support redevelopment initiatives.
