

RESOLUTION NO. 2006- 1100

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES ("DHSMV") AND THE CITY OF TAMPA ("CITY") ALLOWING THE CITY ACCESS TO MOTOR VEHICLE RECORDS DATA AND DRIVER LICENSE DATA MAINTAINED BY THE DHSMV; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, TO EXECUTE SAID MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa Parking Division business process requires, and state law allows, motor vehicle tag data be forwarded to the DHSMV when a parking violation occurs; and

WHEREAS, the DHSMV provides to the City the associated registered motor vehicle records and drivers license data which allows the Parking Division to issue summonses in order to secure payment of fees and penalty, where applicable; and

WHEREAS, due to new privacy legislation, DHSMV now requires written authorization in order to continue providing customer information to the CITY; and

WHEREAS, DHSMV and CITY agree to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for Drivers License or Motor Vehicle Record Data Exchange.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the Memorandum of Understanding between DHSMV and the CITY concerning the Drivers License or Motor Vehicle Record Data Exchange, a copy of which is attached hereto is hereby approved in its entirety or in substantially similar form.

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Tampa is authorized and empowered to execute, and the City Clerk to attest and affix the official Seal of the City of Tampa to, said Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the City of Tampa, Florida.

Section 3. That other proper officers of the City of Tampa are hereby authorized and empowered to do all things necessary in order to carry out and make effective the provisions of this resolution, which shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
