The park has outdoor ADA restroom facilities located within a few feet of the splash pad.

Notes

The park will be very busy on the weekend with community events and traffic from the Tampa Riverwalk.

The Tampa Bay History Center is located at the East end of the park.

The Tampa Riverwalk has a steady flow of traffic during the day, which will include runners, cyclist, Segways, dog walkers, and skateboarders.

There are lots of things to see here. It might be bright or hurt my eyes in places where I see this. I can wear sunglasses or cover my eyes.




There are lots of things to touch here. There might be things that I feel uncomfortable touching when I see this. I do not have to touch anything that I do not want to.

When I see this there will be things I can taste here. I do not have to put anything in my mouth if I do not want to.



There will be rules that I have to follow when I am at the Park. There will be signs to remind me of what the rules.




I will make sure I throw my trash into trash cans. If I have a service animal with me, I will make sure I clean up after him or her.

While we are in the park, we might need to use the restroom. We ask the adult we are with before we go to the restroom.




The Playground & Splash Pad
