A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING NOVEMBER 19, 2020 AT 9:00 A.M., AS THE DATE AND TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, REGARDING THE CITY'S FY2021 1-YEAR ACTION PLAN WHICH INCLUDES THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM, EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANTS PROGRAM, HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM, AND HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS PROGRAM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, 24 CFR PART 91.105 requires any applicant for federal funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383), must provide satisfactory assurances that, prior to the development of its Action Plan, there has been held at least one public hearing for the purpose of obtaining the views of citizens regarding community development, housing, and priority non-housing needs.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, THAT:

- **Section 1**. That the City Council of the City of Tampa does hereby designate November 19, 2020, at 9:00 A.M., or as soon thereafter as practicable, as the date and time for a public hearing by the City Council regarding the Community Development Block Grant Program, Emergency Solutions Grant Program, HOME Investment Partnership Program, and the Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS Program.
- **Section 2**. That this public hearing shall be held pursuant to the provisions contained in 24 CFR 91.105.
- **Section 3**. That the purpose of this public hearing shall be to consider the Community Development Block Grant Program, Emergency Solutions Grant Program, HOME Investment Partnership Program, and the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Program in relation with the City's FY2021 1 Year Plan.
- **Section 4**. That such notice as required by the provisions of 24 CFR 91.105, shall be published in the form of the copy attached hereto or substantially similar form.
