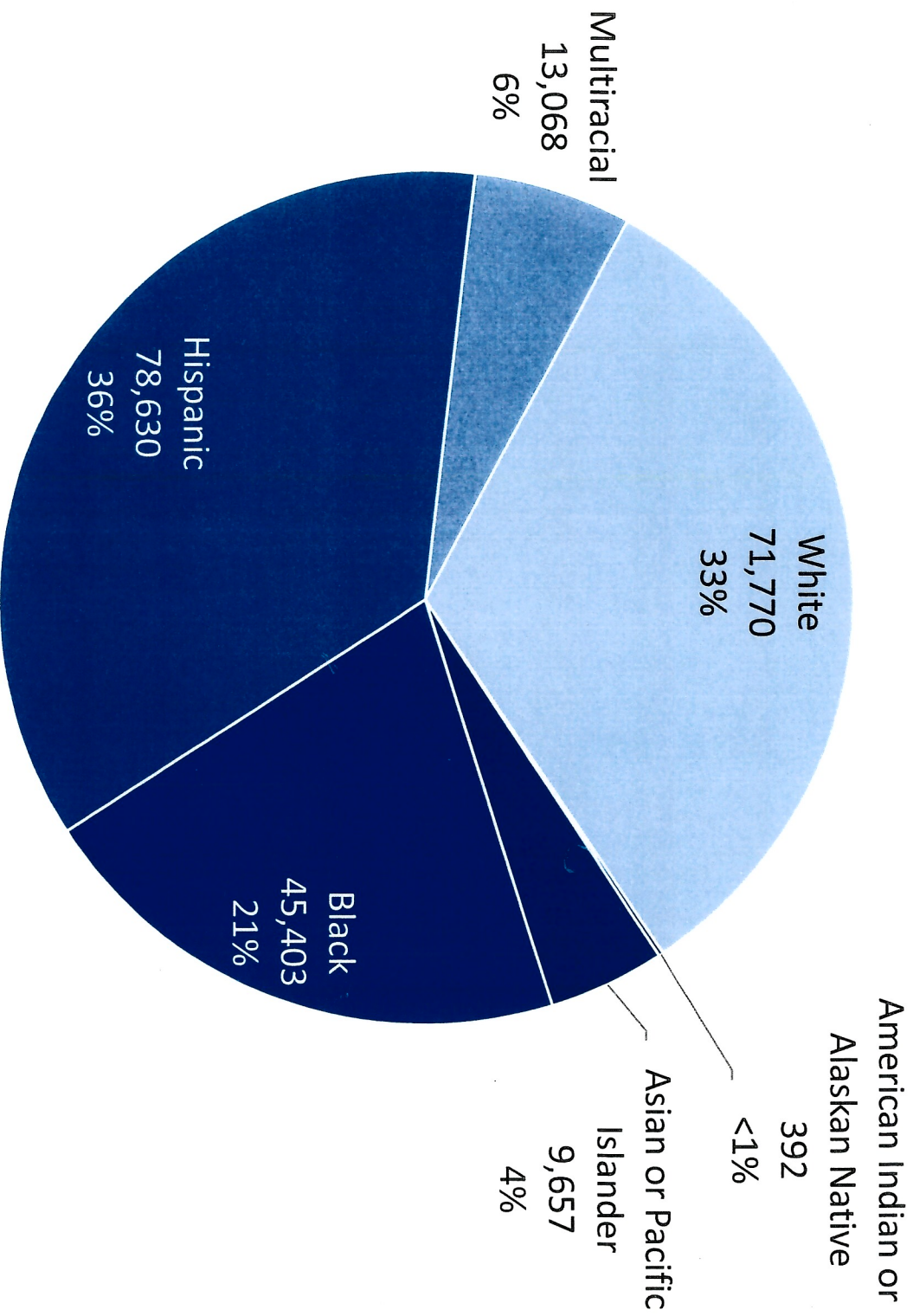
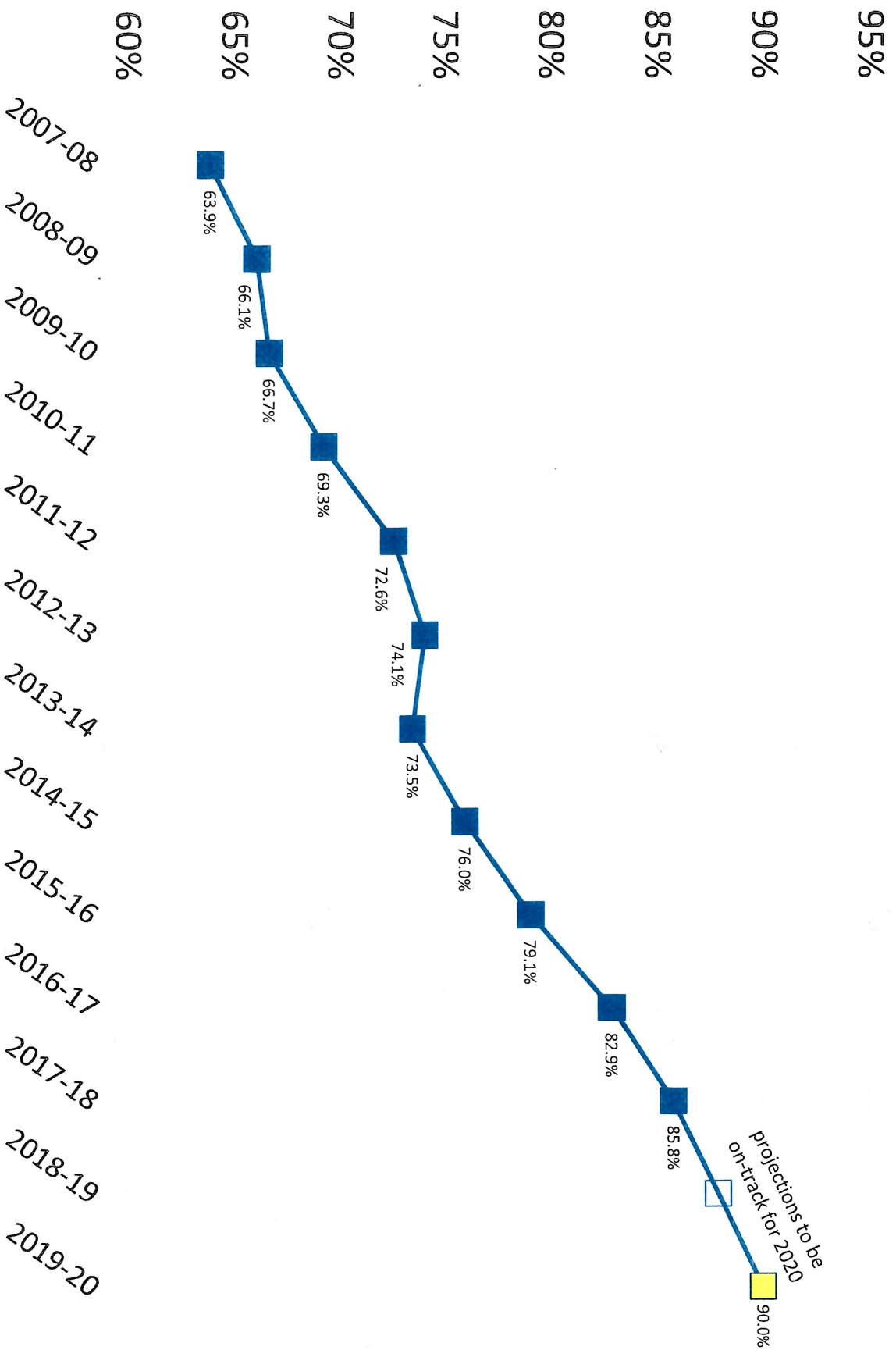


# 2019-20 HCPs PK-12 Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity (Total Enrollment = 218,920)

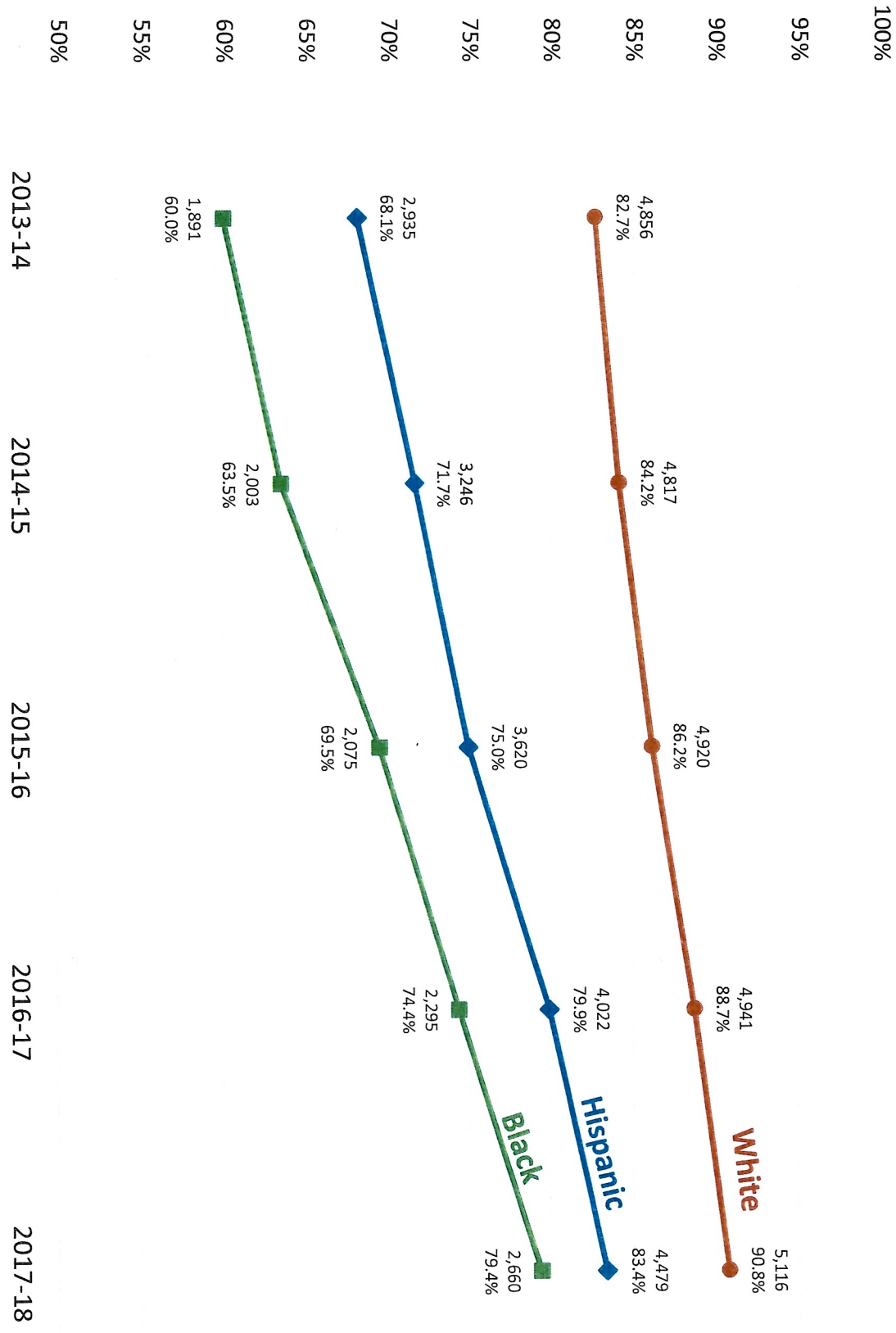

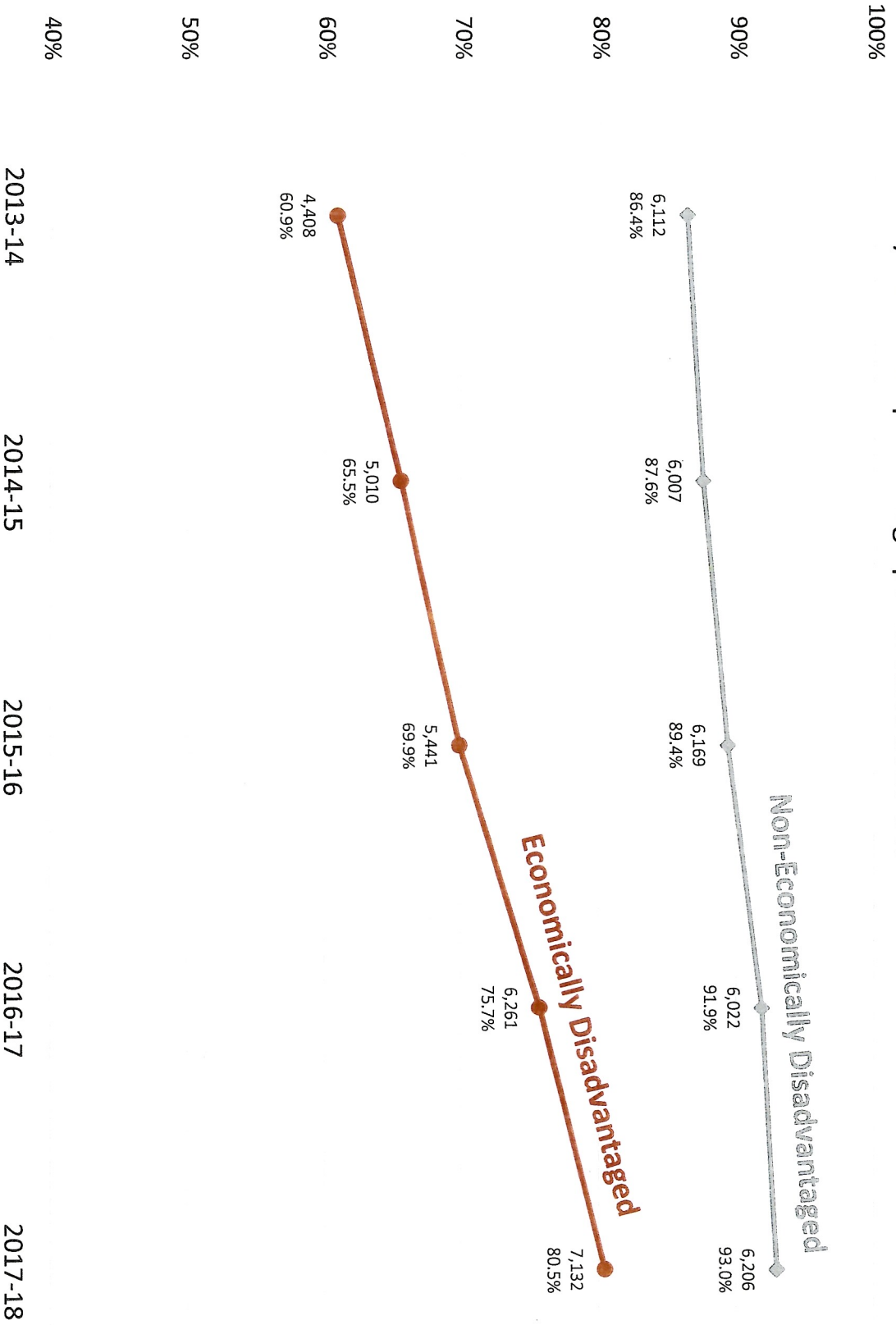
# Hillsborough County Public Schools Graduation Rate



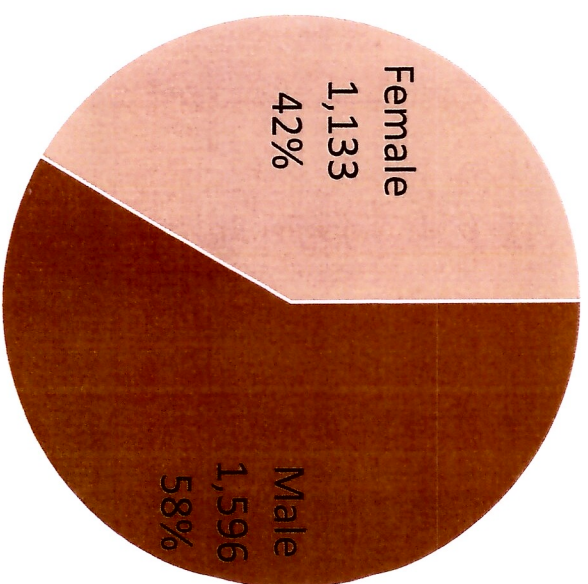
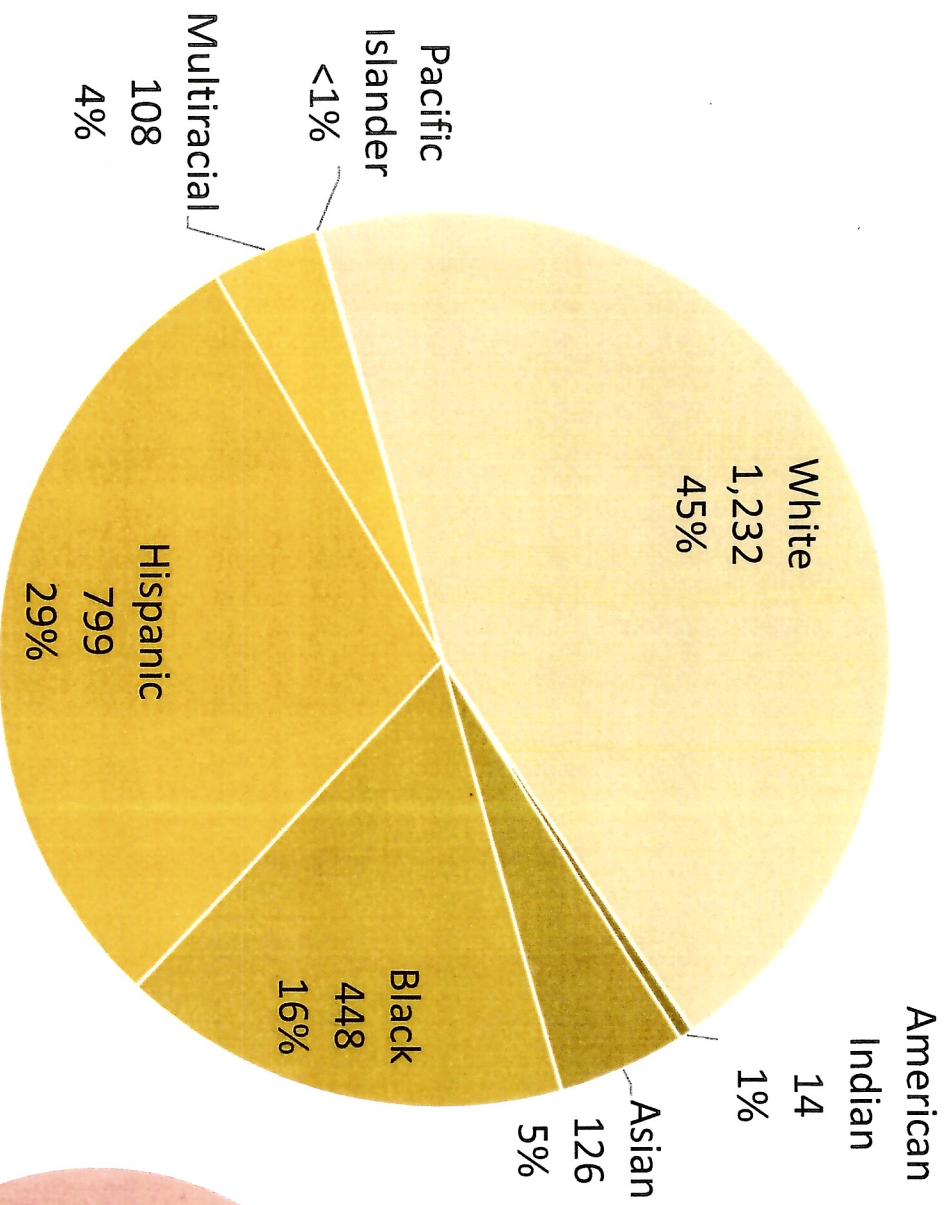
Graduation rates for all 3 major racial/ethnic subgroups have increased over time, with **Black students** showing the greatest growth (19.5 percentage points).



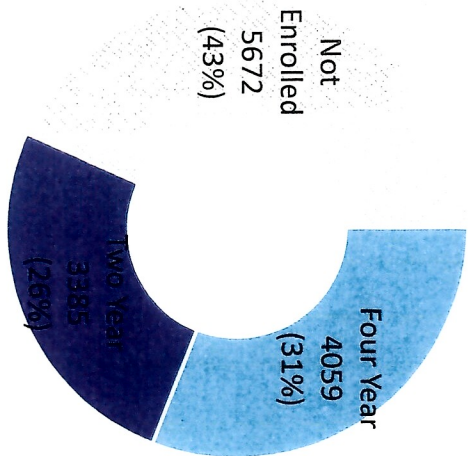
The graduation rate for **Students who are Economically Disadvantaged** has increased by almost 20 percentage points since 2013-14!



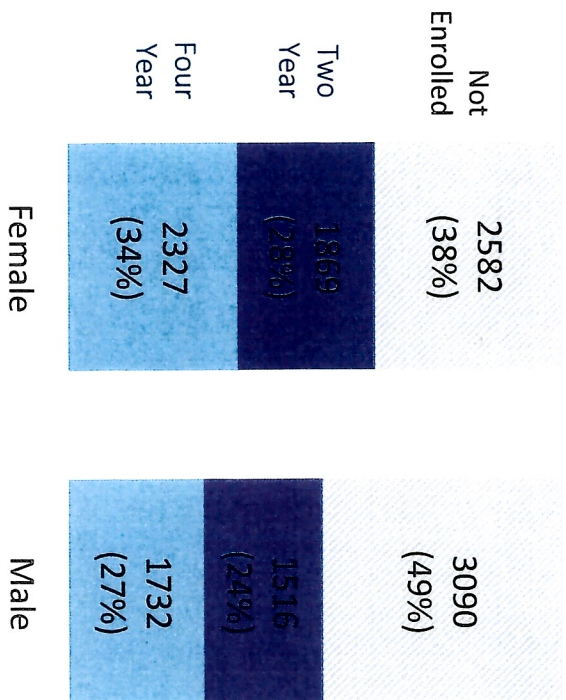
# 2017-18 HCPS Graduates Who Earned Industry Certification by Race/Ethnicity and Gender (Total = 2,729)



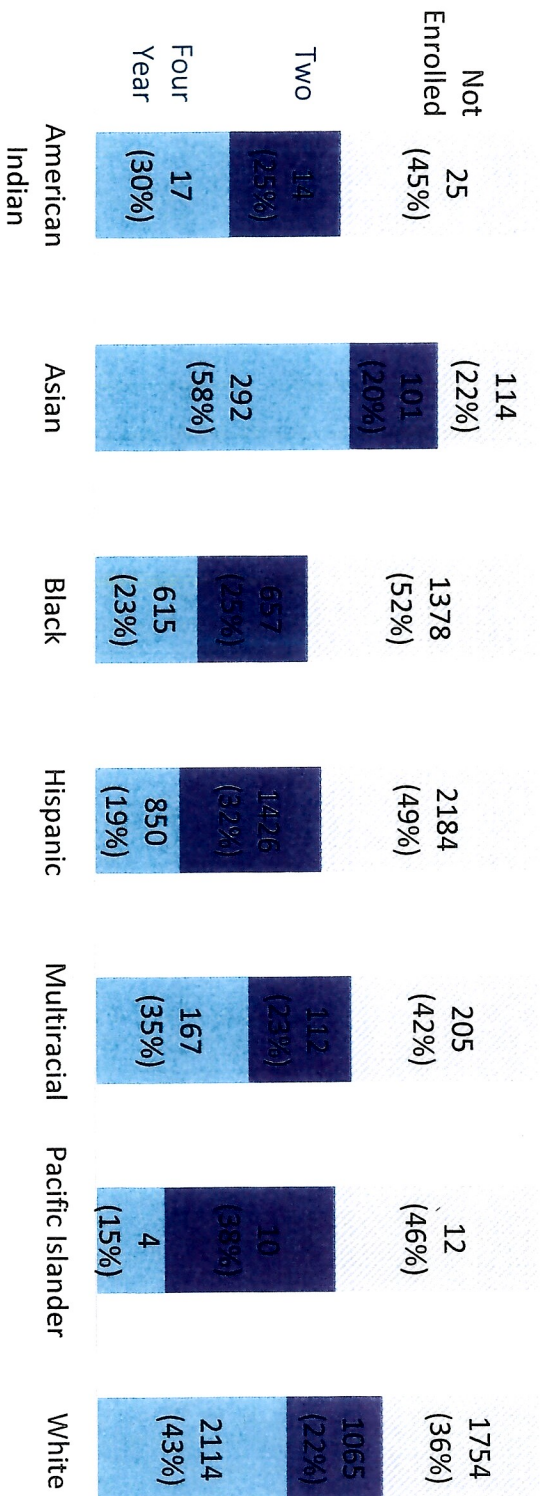
Enrollment of 2017-18 Graduates

College Enrollment of 2017-18 Graduates by Race



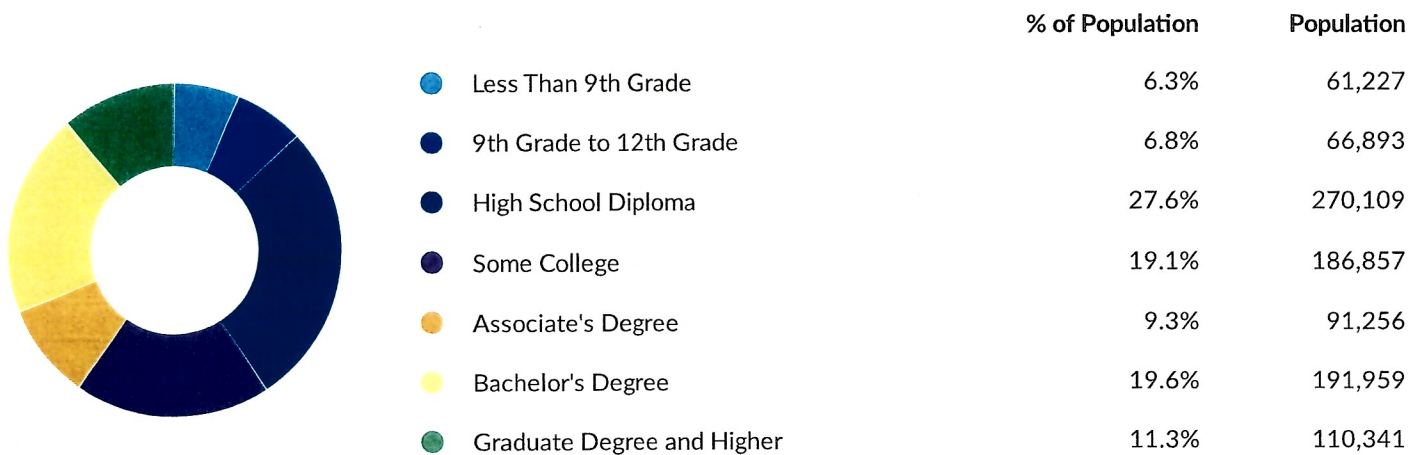

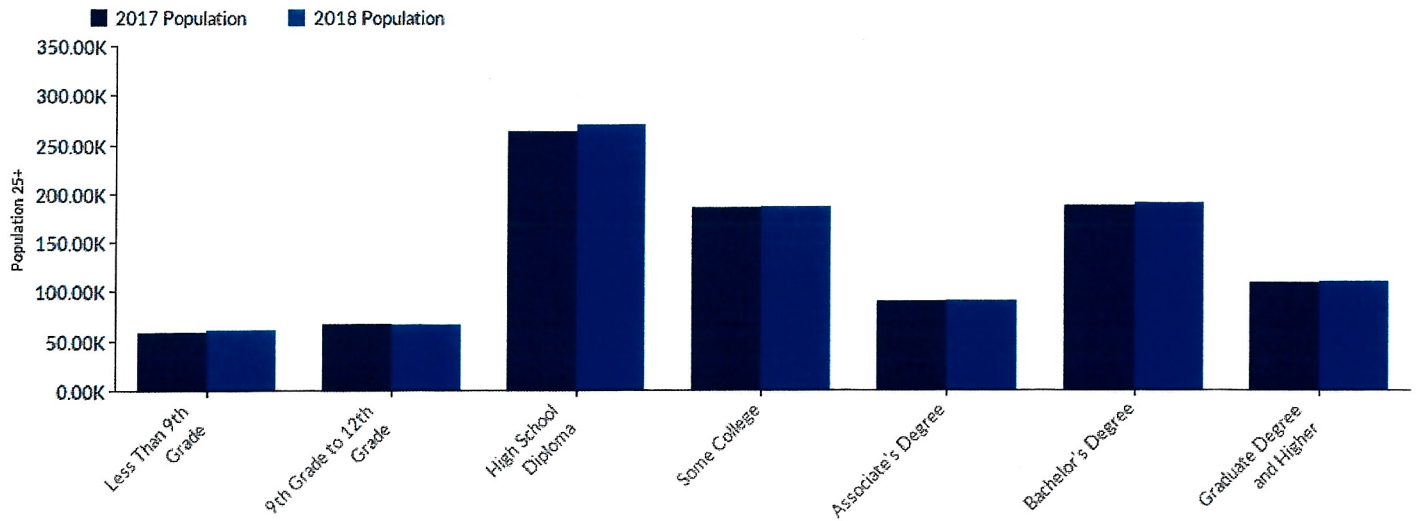


### Educational Attainment

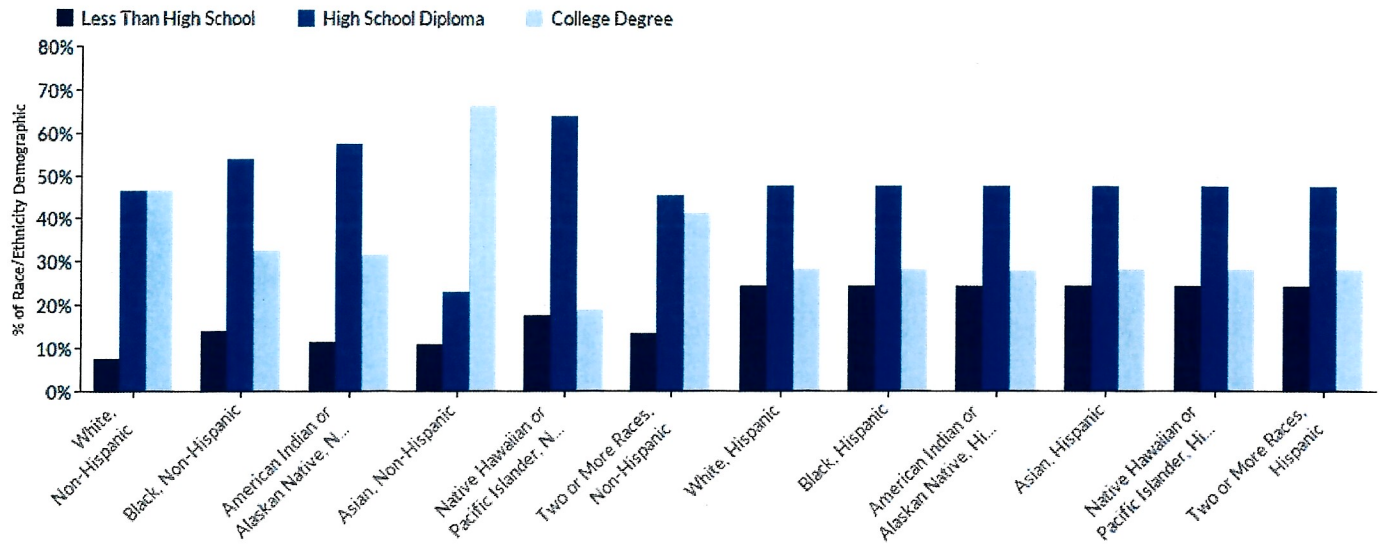

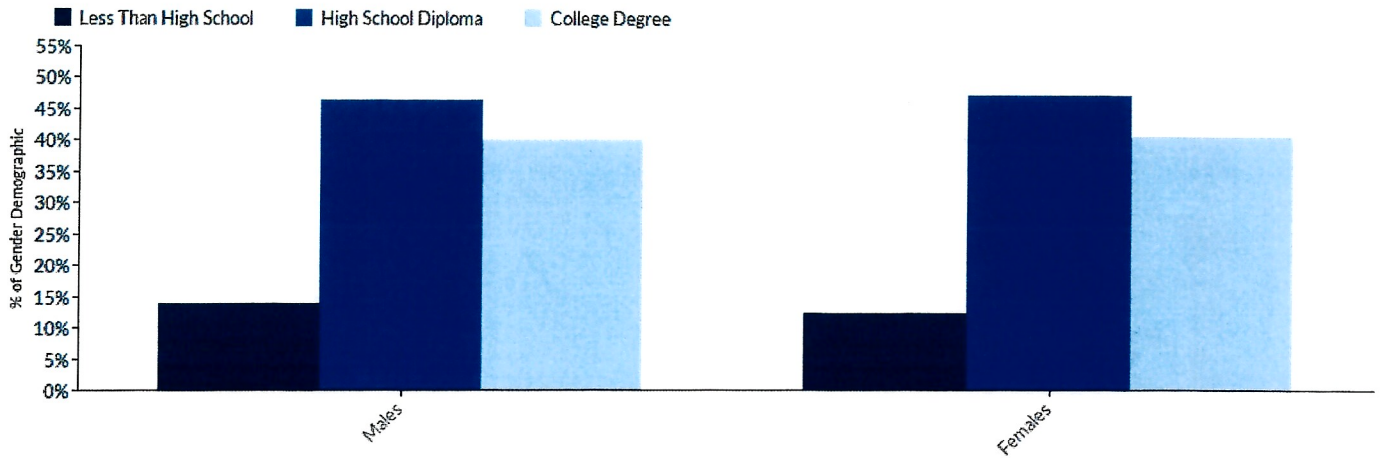
