A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE AFFILIATION OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, U.S.A., AND THE CITY OF IZMIR, TURKEY, AS SISTER CITIES.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Sister Cities program is to provide many opportunities to citizens of both cities to participate in youth activities, student exchanges in high school, colleges and universities, and cultural trade and area development; and,

WHEREAS, this program helps to build a closer relationship between the citizens of these two great cities and further developments of programs that will compliment the purposes of Sister Cities International; and,

WHEREAS, City Council is proud to have the City of Tampa participate in that outstanding international program.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the City Council endorses the affiliation of the City of Tampa, Florida, and the City of Izmir, Turkey, which affiliation will be commemorated in the City of Tampa during the week of February 4, 1993.
