

Monster Mix-up Game

Supplies:

- Paper
- Something to draw with. If you have a thick black marker, that is best to make the outlines. However, any marker, pencil, or pen will be fine.
- Scissors, but if none are available you can fold and score the paper and gently tear along the crease line.
- A container for each category - eyes, nose, mouth, and face/body shapes.

Step 1- Draw different styles of eyes on one sheet, different mouths on another, different noses on the next and different face or body shapes. You can be adventurous and make additional categories beyond what is shown in the video. Other options are things like ears, arms, or feet. Be creative. See how many other categories you can think of to draw.

Step 2- Cut out each item and place each category in a separate container – ex. all the eyes in one container, all the noses in another, and so forth and so on.

Step 3- Close your eyes or have someone pull one out one item from each container.

Step 4- Now draw what was pulled from the container to create your monster.

Each time your monster will be different. See how many monsters you can create!
