Notes

The park is usually busy in the mornings and evenings with runners and cyclist, who utilize the paved trails.

There is limited on-street parking available in the park.

There are a rope play structure and a seated Zipline located near the parking lot. There is also a 1-mile paved walking trail the connects to Flatwoods Park.

This is a nature park, and as such you will encounter wild life in the park. The most commonly seen animals are wild hogs and turkeys. You may encounter snakes sunbathing on the paved exercise trail.

There are lots of things to see here. It might be bright or hurt my eyes in places where I see this. I can wear sunglasses or cover my eyes.




There are lots of things to touch here. There might be things that I feel uncomfortable touching when I see this. I do not have to touch anything that I do not want to.


Park Day
