



Commerce Park Blvd Widening

Project Description:

The project consisted of the widening of Commerce Park Boulevard, from a two-lane section to a four-lane divided facility with on-street bicycle lanes. The project limits are from Primrose Lake Circle south of the New Tampa Community Park Entrance, to the northern tie-in with the adjacent New Tampa Bridge project. The project also adds a new traffic signal at the northern driveway entrance to Freedom High School. The project was constructed within existing right-of-way.

Project Benefit:

This project is adjacent to Freedom High School and Liberty Middle School, and connects to the New Tampa Boulevard extension and Bridge over I-75. Widening of this segment improves the flow of traffic, provides adequate queue storage volume for the left-turn lane; and improves traffic control during peak periods. The improvements will also accommodate the increased traffic volumes due to the New Tampa Blvd Bridge connection.
