

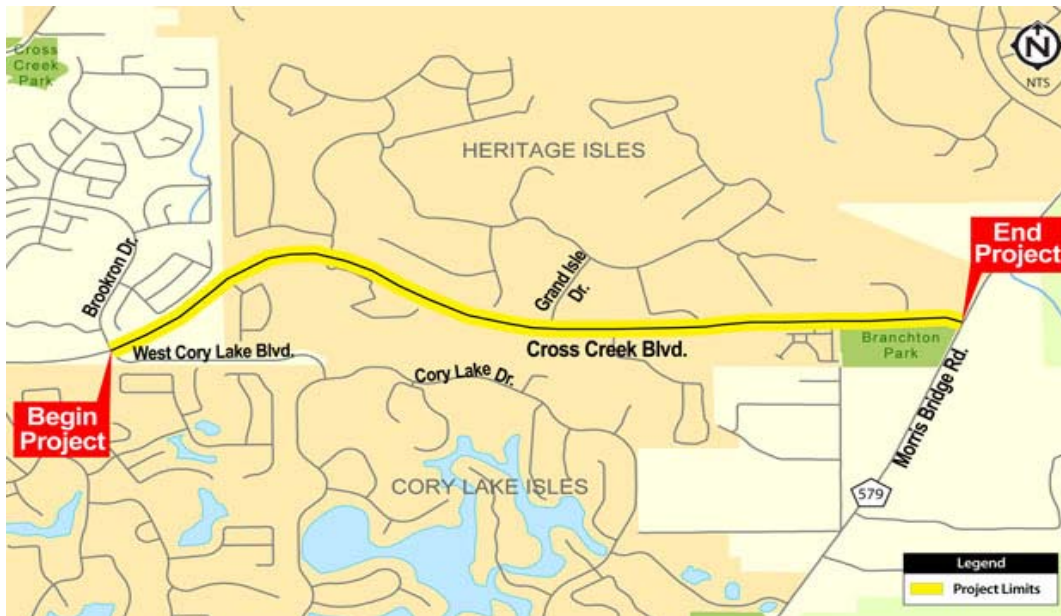


Cross Creek Blvd Widening (from W. Cory Lake Blvd to Morris Bridge Rd) FPID #420625-1; Project #0000307

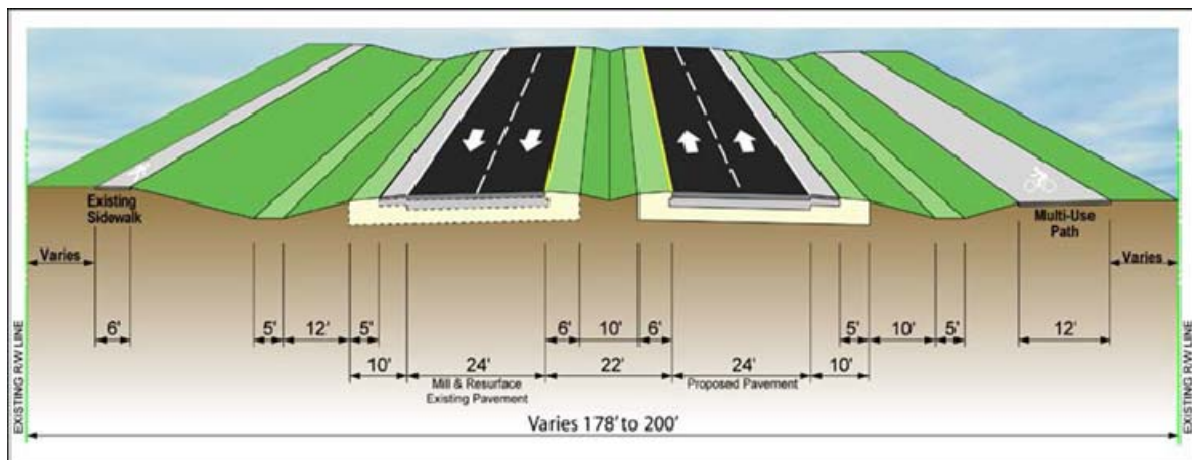
Project Description:

The project consists of widening of a 2.3-miles segment of Cross Creek Boulevard from W. Cory Lake Blvd. to Morris Bridge Road from the existing two-lane undivided to four-lane divided roadway. The project will be constructed within existing right-of-way. The project includes a 6-ft sidewalk along the northern roadside; a 12-ft wide multi-use path along the southern roadside; 5-ft wide on-road bicycle lanes; a 22-ft wide median; and upgraded signalization.
