

## RESPONSIBLE BAR PATRON CHECKLIST

Stop the spread of COVID-19.
Keeping Tampa's bars open depends on all of us.

Following Governor DeSantis' Executive Order 20-139 effective June 5, 2020

Bars may not exceed 50% of allowable capacity inside. When the max capacity is reached, no one else may be admitted.
No seat, No Service. All patrons must be SEATED to be served.  If tables are filled, you must leave the establishment.
You may not stand around with a drink, inside or outside of a bar. You must be seated at a table or leave the establishment.
Move along. Lingering and loitering at the entrance of an establishment is prohibited.
<b>Refrain from singing or loud talking.</b> Both of these activities are linked to high rates of COVID-19 transmission.
Maintain a 6-foot distance from those not in your group whenever possible.
Wash your hands regularly.
Wear facial coverings when not drinking or eating. Facial coverings should be worn when in public or when safe social distancing cannot be maintained.
Do not gather in groups of more than 50.
Get tested for COVID-19 Call (888) 513-6321 for free testing.  No symptoms necessary. Insurance not required.
The state ABT is conducting site visits to bars in Tampa. Patrons not following the rules could result in a \$500 fine, 60 days in jail or closure of the establishment.
