ADA Accessible sidewalks and restrooms

Rowlett Park has two playgrounds located in the park. The playgrounds have mulch surfaces and ADA accessible sidewalks.

The park has outdoor ADA restroom facilities located near the playgrounds.

Notes

The park will be very busy with joggers, walkers, bicycle riders, and dog walkers. There is a little league baseball complex located across the street from the park. The parking lots are heavily used year-round for the little league and for youth football games.

There are large shelters located near the playground, which can be reserved in advance through our online shelter reservation process.

There is also a large outdoor hockey rink located on the north side of the park. The rink is also lined for wheelchair softball.

You may want to bring your own water or drinks, as there is not a water fountain within walking distance of the playgrounds.

There are lots of things to see here. It might be bright or hurt my eyes in places where I see this. I can wear sunglasses or cover my eyes.




There are lots of things to touch here. There might be things that I feel uncomfortable touching when I see this. I do not have to touch anything that I do not want to.

Rules

*There will be rules that I have to follow
when I am at the Park. There will be signs
to remind me of what the rules.*



Trash

I will make sure I throw my trash into trash cans. If I have a service animal with me, I will make sure I clean up after him or her.



Rest

If I get tired, there will be places in the park where I can sit and rest.



Restrooms

While we are in the park, we might need to use the restroom. We ask the adult we are with before we go to the restroom.



The Playground

There will be a playground where I can play. I will take turns with other kids on the equipment. I will stay on the playground where the adult that is with me can see me.



Things to do

While at the playground, there will be lots of things that we can look at or play with, like this sand. I will ask the adult that is with me if I can touch and play with the sand before I touch it.



Dog Park

There is a dog park in Rowlett Park. If I have a service animal, he or she can play here at the dog park. The dog park looks fun for dogs, but it is not for kids to play on.
