

# PROGRAM PERFORMANCE REPORT

AGENCY: <u>Tampa Bay WaVE Inc.</u>

PROGRAM: Operational Support in Program Development and Delivery

REPORT PERIOD: October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019

### I. ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

# The following list summarizes the work we have done since March 2013:

- A total of <u>281 companies</u> have been supported either by the WaVE Accelerator program, the WaVE Tech Venture Center, or both since their launch in March 2013. Of the companies, <u>16</u> were founded by veterans and <u>56</u> by women.
- As of this reporting date, there are <u>82 companies</u> still being actively supported, including <u>57 active companies</u> in the WaVE Accelerator programs
- A total of <u>1.730 jobs</u> have been created & retained (including <u>428</u> contract/1099 jobs) by companies supported by WaVE programs.
- Companies supported by WaVE have raised over \$223 million in outside capital, of which \$130 million was raised since joining one of the WaVE programs.
- A total of <u>2.005</u> events were held with, <u>26.144</u> attendees since the launch of the WaVE Tech Venture Center in downtown Tampa.
- As of this reporting date, there are a total of 89 members of our Mentor Network actively engaged.

# The following list summarizes the work we have done since October 1, 2018:

- Since Oct 2018, a total of <u>107 companies</u> have been supported either by the WaVE Accelerator program, the WaVE Tech Venture Center, or both. Of the companies, at least 6 were founded by veterans and 34 by women.
- Since Oct 2018, A total of <u>312 jobs</u> have been created & retained (including <u>1</u> contract/1099 jobs) by companies supported by WaVE programs.
- Since Oct 2018, Companies supported by WaVE have raised \$30million in outside capital, of which \$20.5 million was raised since joining one of the WaVE programs.
- Since Oct 2018, WaVE has hosted <u>749 events</u> with <u>4,575 attendees</u> in downtown Tampa. In addition, Wave client company have hosted another <u>645</u> meetings with <u>3,332 attendees</u> in downtown Tampa.

Tampa Bay Wave has seen an ever-growing number of post-revenue companies join our programs. As of September 30, 2019, WAVE now supports 43 post-revenue companies, including 16 in the GROW phase of our program. Collectively these GROW companies have raised over \$123MM and created 471 jobs (a average of 29+ jobs per company!).

#### II. PROBLEMS:

One on-going issue that continues to plague the companies we support is the general lack of early-stage capital options (generally in the \$50k - \$3million range). With better funding options, our startups can better accelerate their growth and create more jobs. Tampa Bay has traditionally lagged behind its peers that have strong and/or visible angel investor networks. Tampa Bay even has a history of losing some of its startups to other regions with better capital options. While we continue to help our companies become more "fundable", we can always use more support to foster more angel investor activity in the region.
