*Irrigation water base charges do not apply if you use reclaimed irrigation water.

Water Rates By Threshold Level and Tier

Tiers	Threshold Level (Monthly consumption)	Inside City	Outside City
1	Up to the threshold amount	\$2.86	\$3.57
2	From the threshold amount up to twice the threshold amount	\$4.80	\$6.00
3	From twice the threshold up to three and one-half the threshold amount	\$6.40	\$8.00
4	Over three and one-half times the threshold amount	\$7.39	\$9.23

Threshold Levels represent monthly water use allotments to encourage water conservation. The more water you use, the more you pay. Non-residential accounts are assigned to a classification according to their business type. Below is an example of monthly threshold levels for a business classified as "Medium Commercial."

- **Tier 1:** 1 ccf to 140 ccfs
- **Tier 2:** 141 ccfs to 280 ccfs
- **Tier 3:** 281 ccfs to 490 ccfs
- **Tier 4:** 491 ccfs and higher

Reclaimed Water Irrigation Rates, All Classifications (Where Available)

Consumption	Inside City Only
Per ccf	\$1.20

Wastewater Rates, All Classifications

Consumption	Inside City	Outside City
Per ccf	\$5.15	\$6.43

Understanding consumption measurements and rates

- **Consumption Measurements:** Your water, wastewater, and irrigation is billed in ccf units. Each ccf unit is equal to 100 cubic feet, which is the same as 748 gallons.
- **Rates:** Rates vary depending on whether your service location is within the City of Tampa or in Hillsborough County.
