



Goals of this Phase:


- 1. Further identify specific **concerns** and **strengths** of the community

What are the Available Tools?

Tax Increment Financing

unity Organizing

- Captures incremental tax revenue caused by rising property value to be used in neighborhood
- A method to improve neighborhood conditions through the tax that improvements generate
- Regulated by Florida State law
- Can be used on:
 - The development of affordable housing
 - The development of community policing innovations
 - The improvement of infrastructure
 - The acquisition of real property
 - The preparation of any redevelopment area for redevelopment



Increase to \$1,693,000 projected for 2021

Regulation & Administration unity Organizing

- The Strategic Action Plan Update can recommend the City of Tampa make certain regulatory changes regarding Drew Park
- Common recommendations relate to
 - Zoning and Future Land Use Changes
 - Code Enforcement Strategies
 - Law Enforcement Activities

Community Organizing

- The Strategic Action Plan Update can identify strategies the Community Advisory Committee and other organizations can use to achieve the goals








