Ybor City Design Guidelines:

Dennis Fernandez – Agenda item #7, Kick-Off Presentation for the Ybor City Design Guidelines by consultant S&ME. The current guidelines were adopted in 1984 and updated in 1986, along with a few other updates over the years. We are at a point that they need to comprehensively be updated, and we have hired the firm of S&ME who will provide an overview of their firm and the process they will be using.

Camaria Pettis-Mackle, Assistant City Attorney – provided guidance on the Historic Preservation Commission's responsibilities under Code Section 27-264 (d) as they pertain to the Historic District Guidelines.

S&ME – Pat Tyjeski, Agent representing S&ME, provided a PowerPoint presentation outlining the project scope, the S&ME team, and the process to complete the project.

Dennis Fernandez – This is an open forum for questions and answers. No actions will take place today.

Commissioners asked questions about the consultant's process and timing of gathering information.

Dennis Fernandez – We will engage various groups within the district and be as inclusive as we can be. If you have suggestions on a group or person who should be involved, please email us and we will add them to our list to reach out. The existing guidelines were really focused on the rehabilitation and adaptive reuse. As we move into this review of the guidelines, we will be paying special attention to the miscellaneous and new construction areas which have a big impact on the area. We are moving from guidelines to standards. We do not get a lot of funding for this purpose with that we want to produce a document that can evolve as the district evolves. A contributor to this project will be the Barrio Latino Commission which we will be providing this overview to at their Public Hearing on January 26, 2021.

Preservation Park:

Dennis Fernandez – Staff has been in communication with State officials regarding the change in status of the structures at the Ybor City State Museum Park from non-contributing to contributing. This item will be presented at the next HPC meeting.

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
