Mr. Burkett and Ms. Webe**h**began by reminding the committee of the varying responses the Fund has **h** received over the years from FRS regarding whether or not prior service credit will be relinquished by **h** FRS for purchase by Tampa plan members. The main concern was the liability of members potentially doubling up on service time purchased.

Following a period of discussion, it was recommended that question #7 on the Fund's service purchase h credit form be removed and a statement of indemnification be added to future buyback award letters. h Mr. Burkett also recommended prior individuals with FRS buyback credit be sent notifications. h
