Also present were Dr. Bruce Bohnker, Medical Director; and Mr. Robert Klausner, General Counsel.

Ms. Weber began by providing an overview of the work the Pension Office has recently done to try and secure the services of a new Medical Director in light of Dr. Bohnker's impending retirement. She stated that, in her opinion, Tampa General Hospital provided a thorough response, which offered a streamlined temporary and immediate solution. It also would provide access to Dr. Bohnker during the interim period, as he is contracting with them after retirement from COMBI. She expounded that they proposed an interim 90-day period beginning June 1, 2022, with the possibility of an annual contract going forward.

Discussion and questions from the Committee members followed. Mr. Klausner provided statements h supporting Ms. Weber's opinions. The recommendation to engage with Tampa General Hospital for a 90-day interim period and to issue an RFI for a permanent Medical Director was agreed upon by general consensus.
