
WHEREAS, the Sister City Program administered by Sister Cities International was initiated by the President of the United States of America in 1956 to encourage greater friendship and understanding between the United States and other nations through direct personal contact; and

WHEREAS, to foster those goals, the people of the City of Tampa, Florida, United States of America, and South Dublin County, Ireland, in a gesture of friendship and goodwill, agree to collaborate for the mutual benefit of their communities by exploring educational, economic, and cultural opportunities; and

WHEREAS, we agree to support and courage opportunities for mutually beneficial practical exchanges in the fields of Arts, Culture, Health, Science, Education, Tourism, and Business.

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Tampa and South Dublin County do hereby proclaim themselves Sister Cities and declare their intent to abide by these guidelines indefinitely according to the Sister Cities International policies.

This document goes into effect on the date of signature.


