
You do **not** need to have an Accela account or be logged in to search for general public records.



- 2. On the Home screen, click on Search Applications under the Building menu.








- 3. Click into the General Search field to expand the drop-down menu and select Search by Address.
  - a. You do <u>not</u> need to adjust the Start / End Date fields. Address search results are not restricted by date ranges (see step #3).



4. For best results, enter only the Street Number and Street Name fields; then click Search.



5. If your search returns multiple results, you will need to select the address that corresponds to your search by clicking on the blue link.
