NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND 30 DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD CONCERNING HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FUNDING

A Meeting of the City Council of the City of Tampa has been called by the Chair of the City Council to conduct a second public hearing on the City of Tampa's Fiscal Year ("FY") 2024/Program Year ("PY") 2023 Annual Action Plan, which includes the Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG"), Emergency Solutions Grants Program ("ESG"), Home Investment Partnerships ("HOME") and the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Program ("HOPWA"). This hearing will be conducted with a live in-person quorum of the City Council present in City Council Chambers. Members of the public can attend in person in City Council Chambers or virtually participate in this public meeting by using the methods described herein.

The purpose of this Public Hearing shall be to:

- 1) Present information concerning the FY2024/PY2023 Annual Action Plan, including the CDBG, ESG, HOME, and HOPWA programs. Information shall include, but not be limited to, the types of activities previously undertaken, anticipated level of funding, range of eligible activities, and other pertinent program requirements. This information may be provided in writing.
- 2) Open the 30 day public comment period which will run from June 22, 2023 to July 23, 2023.**
- 3) Obtain the views and comments of citizens concerning community development, priority housing and non-housing needs at the initial stage of program to be used by City staff in the preparation of the FY2024/PY2023 Annual Action Plan.
- 4) Afford to any person or organization the opportunity to be heard on this subject.
- 5) Announce the release of the Fiscal Year 2024/ Program Year 2023 Request for Proposals for program funding.
