

July 2023 Amendment Cycle

Tentative proposed amendments (subject to change):

- Amendment 23-11: Article 3, Division 2, Subdivision 3, "Central Business District"- Update the CBD street typologies map to reflect existing and imminent changes to the street grid. Amend Type B and C street details.
- Amendment 23-12: Sections 27-91, 27-211, 27-231, 27-271, 27-330- Clarify that historic district requirements take precedence over the general zoning code.
- Amendment 23-13: Section 27-150- Adds language specifying that a rezoning ordinance is deemed automatically withdrawn when a comprehensive plan amendment is not approved.
- Amendment 23-14: Section 27-21- Cleanup of footnote reference in the Consistency Matrix.
- Amendment 23-15: Section 19-58, 27-287.25- Enforcement of hazardous grand tree removals.
- Amendment 23-16: Section 283.11- Updates to commercial vehicle parking standards.
- Amendment 23-17: Section 27-149- Expand notice area; require a notice of filing for cases that require a public hearing.
- Amendment 23-18: Section 27-199, Table 19-2 Channel District—Increase maximum height in CD-1 zoning from 60' to 175' to be consistent with CD-2 zoning.

Water Restrictions



Tampa's water use restrictions have been in place and enforced year-round since 1989. Restrictions are subject to change in response to water supply and regional drought conditions. The Tampa Water Department publishes updates and changes to local water restrictions in media releases, Twitter, Facebook, Alert Tampa, Nextdoor, and utility customer billing inserts.

What is My Watering Schedule?

The following schedule applies to properties inside Tampa city limits whose lawns and landscapes are watered with either city water or well water.

Starting December 1, 2023, the City of Tampa will be restricted to once-per-week lawn watering to comply with the Modified Phase I Water Shortage Order declared by the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD), our state's regulatory agency for our region. Additionally, all wasteful use of water, like hosing down driveways or impervious surfaces, is also prohibited. These restrictions also apply to Hillsborough, Pasco, and Pinellas counties.

Citations are issued on first observance by a water use enforcement patroller. Violating water use restrictions in Tampa may result in <u>fines</u> up to \$500 and a mandatory court appearance.
