Courtyard

Defined in 27-211.10 as a frontage type, but not in other sections of the Code. Courtyards are referenced in the overlay districts and specific uses section.

Courtyard:

Merriam Webster: a court or enclosure adjacent to a building (such as a house or palace)

Archdictionary.com: An open space, usually open to the sky, enclosed by a building, often with an arcade or colonnade.

Suggestion: An unoccupied area, not intended for vehicular traffic, other than a yard, on a single zoning lot which is open to the sky but surrounded on at least two sides by a building or buildings or walls.
