





CITY CENTER AT HANNA AVENUE



In January 2022, the City of Tampa broke ground on the <u>City Center at Hanna Ave</u> – an exciting development that will help improve city services, offer a gathering space for the community, and support equal business opportunity. <u>35% of the construction work at the City Center</u> site is being completed by black-owned and small, locally-owned businesses.

The City Center's blend of timelessness and contemporary design qualities continue inside of the 161,000 square feet building. Many of Tampa's unique and cherished neighborhoods, events and areas will be recognized and included Although construction has not yet begun, the foundation for a strong, positive partnership with the neighborhood and the surrounding area has already begun taking place.

The City Center is a blend of timelessness and contemporary design features. Many of Tampa's cherished neighborhoods and unique spaces will be recognized inside the 161,000 square feet building. The architectural artistry that is the City Center at Hanna Avenue is the first major City investment in East Tampa in decades.

The City Center is expected to open in late fall 2023.
