All comments must be received no later than 5:30 PM, Wednesday, May 22, 2024 (24 hours prior to the hearing) in order to be made a part of the official records. Public comments timely received by mail, email, web, or via CMT will be afforded equal consideration as if the public comments were made in person.

The purpose of this Public Hearing shall be to:

- 1) Present information concerning Substantial Amendment to the PY23/FY24 Annual Action Plan.
- 2) Continue to obtain the views and comments of citizens concerning the Substantial Amendment to the Annual Action Plan. Public Comment period will begin on **May 23, 2024, and will continue to June 24, 2024.**
