HOW TO APPLY

1.1. REGISTER

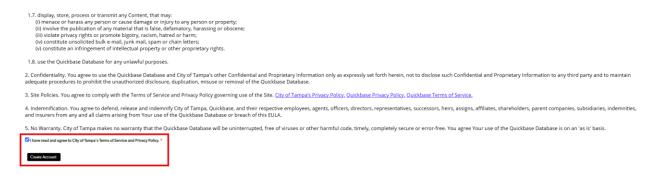
To access the Pre-Application, you will need to create an account.

- On the CityAofATampa's LandingAPage, you will see a link to register:

- 2. To register, enter your First Name, Last Name, and Email.



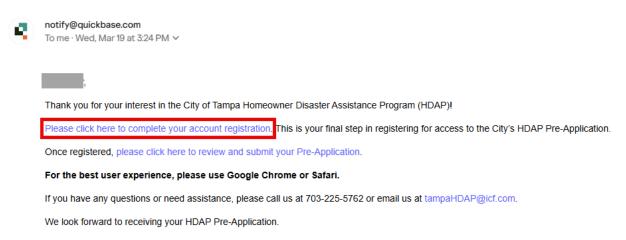
3. Scroll down, read the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy, check the box to confirm you have read and agree to the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy, and then Click#Create Account."A



4. Once you submit your registration form, you will receive confirmation that it has been received.

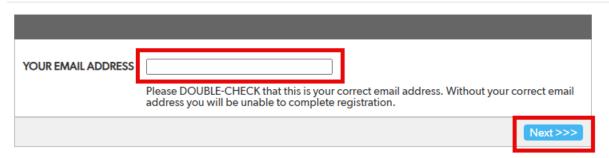


5. To finish the registration process, click the first link within the email.



After clicking the link, you will be asked to re-enter the email for verification. Re-enter your email and click "Next." A

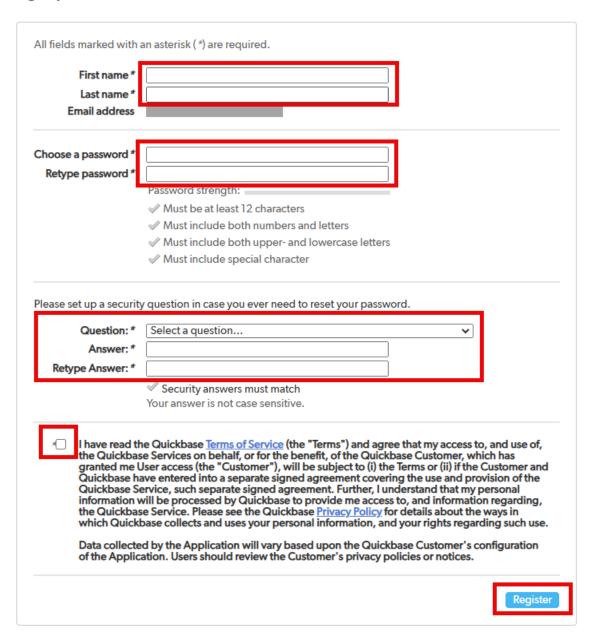




7. Enter your First and Last Name, set a password, and answer a security question. Check the box to confirm reading and agreeing to the Quickbase Terms of Service and the Quickbase Privacy Policy. Click "Register". You will only need to complete this step once.

8. Once that is complete, you will receive confirmation that it has been received, informing you that you need to verify your email address.

You may also want to check your junk mail box and make sure your spam-blocking software has not blocked your confirmation email.

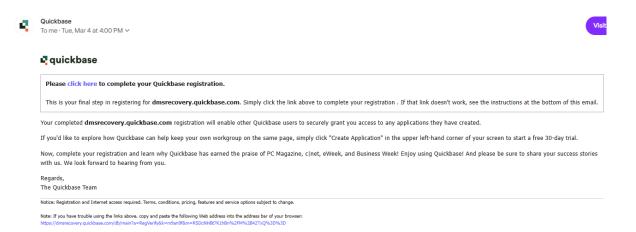

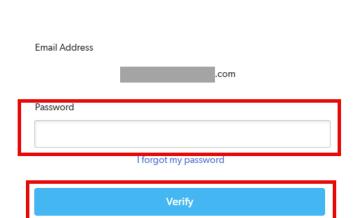

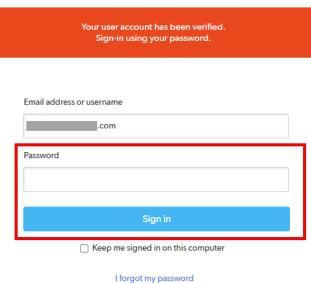


10. You will be directed to the login screen once you click the link. You will need to enter your password and click "Verify." AYou will only need to complete this step once.

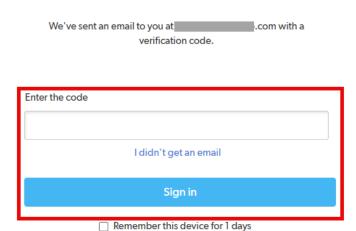
11. Once you click "Verify," Ayour account registration will be verified, and you can log in.



12. As part of the two-factor authentication, you will be asked to enter a code before logging in.

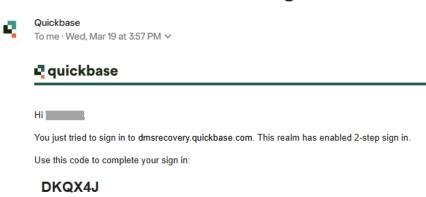

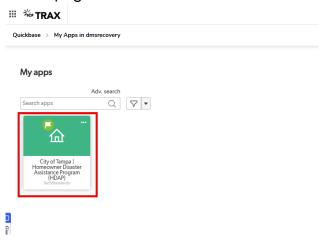
13. You will receive an email with the 6-letter code. Enter this code in the text box and click ASign In." A

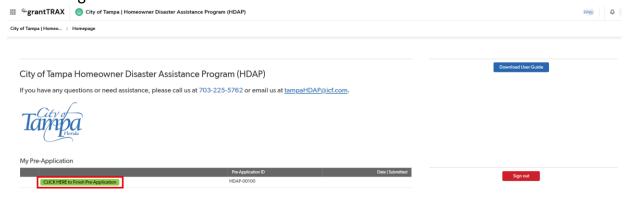

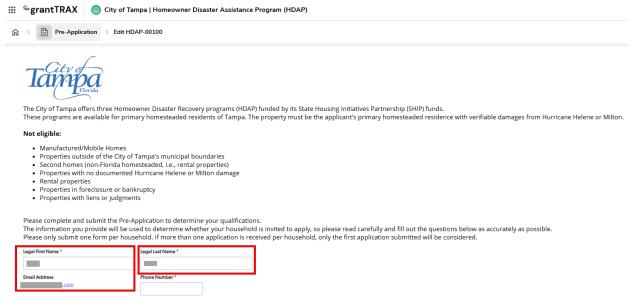
1.2. PRE-APPLICATION

1.2.1. Completing the Pre-Application

 Click the green button – "Click HERE to Finish Pre-Application." A NOTE: You can download the user guide from your homepage by clicking the blue "Download User Guide" Aputton.

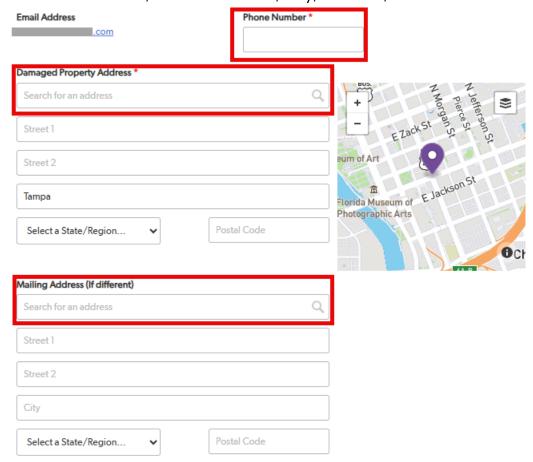


 This will take you to the Pre-Application, where your First Name, Last Name, and Email Address will be prepopulated based on your registration details.

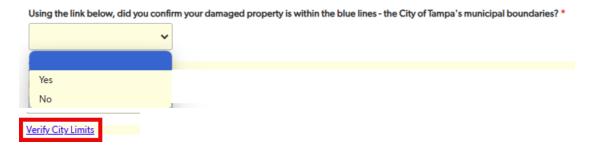


- 3. Fill in your Phone Number.

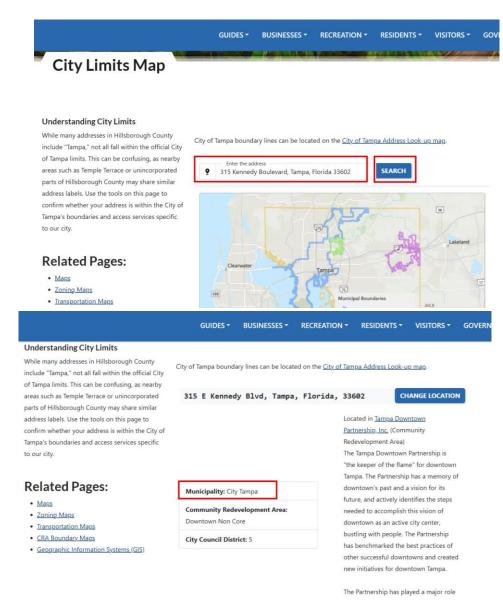

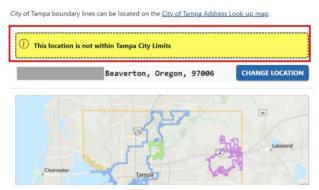
6. Answer the below question by selecting Yes/No from the dropdown by verifying your damaged property using the AVerify City Limits" link In the form.

Note: The message below will appear if your address is not within the City of Tampa limits.



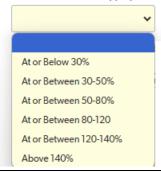

8. Select the most appropriate household income range from the dropdown options below. Refer to the example below to identify your range.

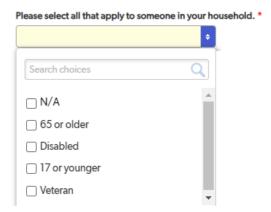

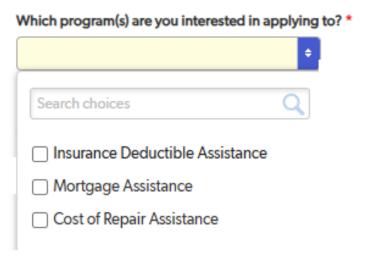
10. Select all program(s) you want to apply from the three programs below.

Insurance Deductible Assistance: The program will assist primary homesteaded homeowners with insurance deductibles for repairs that need to be made or have been made to a home that suffered damages from Hurricane Helene or Milton. Maximum assistance is up to \$10,000. However, only the actual amount of the deductible, as reflected by the insurance claim, will be paid. Applicants will be required to provide proof of FEMA application for Hurricane Helene or Milton and the results, insurance claim payouts, and payments to contractors.

Mortgage Assistance: The program will assist primary homesteaded homeowners with delinquent mortgage payments due to lost wages or displacement from the home resulting from damages caused by Hurricane Helene or Milton. Applicants will be required to provide documentation of displacement or lost wages due to Hurricane Helene or Milton. Maximum assistance is \$5,000 and for no more than 6 months. Applicants must provide proof of home displacement and that the mortgage payment has become delinquent since the hurricane and is at least 31 days past due. Mortgages that were delinquent prior to the hurricane are not eligible. The homeowner must be able to resume paying their mortgage once this assistance has been terminated.

Cost of Repair Assistance: The program will assist homeowners who have made out-of-pocket payments of at least \$500 towards the repair of the home due to damages caused by Hurricane Helene or Milton. Homeowners may receive reimbursement of up to \$20,000. However, only the actual amount paid is

eligible for reimbursement. Applicants will be required to provide receipts and/or invoices showing their payments. The homeowner will be required to show proof that they filed an insurance claim (if they had insurance) and any payments received from the insurance claim. Work must have been completed in accordance with building codes and applicable permits pulled. Inspections may be required.

- 12. Once you have filled in all the required information in the Pre-Application form and selected the checkbox above, you will see the "Submit Pre-Application" button below. Click An ASubmit Pre-Application".

13. Once you submit your Pre-Application, you will see a confirmation that it has been received.



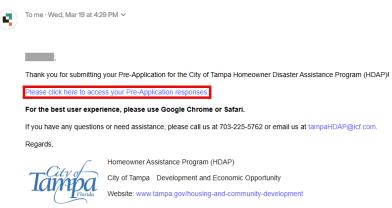

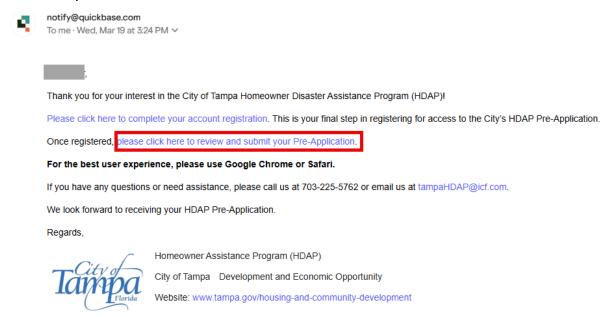

 If you choose to submit your Pre-Application at a later time but have already registered, you can access your pre-application via the second link in your email.



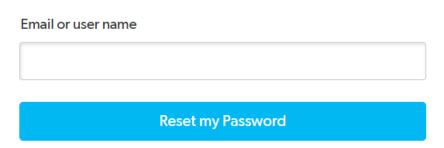
1.3. RESET PASSWORD
