REDEVELOPMENT SPOTLIGHT

WEST TAMPA

WEST RIVER BUILD PROJECT OFFICIALLY BREAKS GROUND

Tampa CRA Board members, staff, and Community Advisory Committee members celebrated the official groundbreaking of the West Riverwalk expansion on October 28, 2025. The project entails a 0.2-mile expansion of the award-winning Tampa Riverwalk on the west side of the Hillsborough River with enhanced lighting, improved sidewalks, and new cycling trails. The project provides car-free transportation routes and improve the safety and mobility between neighborhoods. Tampa CRA is funding \$10 million for improvements within the West Tampa community redevelopment area.





EAST TAMPA

FLORIDA NEGRO WORLD WAR MEMORIAL CEMETERY RESTORATION

Tampa CRA partnered with The Cemetery Society, Tampa Parks and Recreation, and Hillsborough County to restore the Florida Negro World War Veterans Memorial, located at Memorial Park Cemetery. The restoration work was completed by RLA Conservation, a leading art and sculpture conservation group, ensuring the 102-year-old monument maintained its original look.

DREW PARK

ROADWAY AND INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

Safety, connectivity, and mobility are the top priorities for Drew Park's Intersection Improvement Projects. Areas receiving upgrades include N. Hesperides Street, W. Crest Avenue, and various intersections on N. Hubert Avenue and N. Lois Avenue. This project is currently in the design review phase and anticipated to break ground in summer 2026.

TAMPA HEIGHTS RIVERFRONT

NEW ROUNDAPOUT ART

The CRA Art Selection Committee received, reviewed, and scored 150 applications for a roundabout art sculpture project to increase public art in the district. The



committee will meet again in January 2026 to select the finalists for the new public art installations.

DOWNTOWN



HERMAN MASSEY PARK UPDATE

Herman Massey Park renovations continues to make progress inDowntown. In October, the park's new sculpture, created by Miamibased visual artist Alexandre Arrechea, was installed. The renovations also include new paving and lighting which are planned to be completed this winter.

CENTRAL PARK

GASWORX UPDATE

In late October, the six-story office building in the new Gasworx development officially topped out. This building will serve as the future headquarters of Grow Financial. Gasworx also announced the names of three new buildings in the development: The Luisa, Olivette, and



Stevedore. Each building honors the city's rich history and will serve as future residential buildings, adding more than 900 residential units to the area, as well as thousands of square feet of ground-floor retail space.

REDEVELOPMENT SPOTLIGHT

CHANNEL DISTRICT

The CRA Board approved the purchase of a commercial property at 1125 and 1127 E. Twiggs St. in September. This strategic acquisition will enable the addition of more green space in the Channel District and the expansion of Madison Street Park.

Several Tampa CRA staff and Community Advisory Committee (CAC) leaders from Drew Park, Downtown, East Tampa and West Tampa attended the 2025 FRA Conference in West Palm Beach in October to network with CRA professionals across the state and learn best practices. In addition, several CRA staff members graduated from the Florida Redevelopment Academy and now are certified redevelopment professionals. CRA Director Cedric McCray was elected to the FRA Board to represent Tampa following the term limit of FRA Past President Brenda Thrower.

The Tampa CRA awarded HJGE Property Group a Commercial Exterior Grant for 1814 N. 15th St. to replace and update exterior windows and doors, preserving the historic building's appearance.

The Tampa CRA awarded Commercial Exterior and Interior Grants to Mitsaru Services, LLC, to help transform 1702 W. Main St. into a vibrant commercial space for future restaurants and local entrepreneurs.
