Presentations

A. East Tampa Wayfinding and Gateway Signage Project Update, John Scheffel and Erin Konley

- Mr. Scheffel recapped the first phase of the ETCRA wayfinding project.
- Coordination with City of Tampa staff; FDOT
- Wayfinding survey make-up; selections and results
- North bound on 22nd Street, E. bound on Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd and 275, and southbound on 50th Street were highlighted as gateway were identified as primary gateway/identification sign locations.
- Five concepts were shared with ETCAC members in attendance.
- Light pole banners were also incorporated into the concepts being shared.
- Incorporated the East Tampa stamp previously used in the East Tampa strategic action plan in 2021.
- ETCAC members shared their thoughts on the concepts presented. Several appreciated that the consultants listened to previous suggestions from the initial meeting.
- There was some concern that there were only 44 responses from the online survey.
- ETCAC members requested the presentation and concepts be provided to share and solicit feedback from their respective neighborhood organizations.
- A majority of the ETCAC members agreed that concept 4 was most optimal.
