



CITY OF TAMPA ONSTREET PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS:

What are the most common parking violations seen in?

- Parking on/Blocking a Sidewalk
- o Parking within 10 feet of a Driveway
- Parking Facing Oncoming Traffic
- o Parking on or within 20 feet of a Crosswalk
- Parking within 30 feet of any Traffic Control Device:
 - Stop Sign
 - Flashing Signal
 - Traffic Control Signal
- o Parking within 15 feet of a Fire Hydrant
- o Parking across from a Driveway:
 - When the Street is 25 feet Wide or Less

What are other common violations seen in Tampa?

- o Parking on a Bicycle Lane or Shared-Use Path
- Blocking Access to a Mailbox
- Parking within an Intersection
- o Parking on the Roadway Side of a Vehicle Parked at the Curb
- Parking any Place Where Official Traffic Control Devices or Signs Prohibit Parking
- Parking with Tires more than 12 inches from the Curb
