SUBJECT: Suspension of activity in the Right of Way for the 2026 Holidays & Special Events

During the following holidays and designated special events, all activities within the Right of Way will be suspended.

HOLIDAYS

- **Dr Martin Luther King Jr Day** – Monday, January 19, 2026
- **Spring Holiday** – Friday, April 3, 2026
- **Memorial Day** – Monday, May 25, 2026
- **Juneteenth** – Friday, June 19, 2026
- **Independence Day** – Friday, July 3, 2026
- **Labor Day** – Monday, September 7, 2026
- **Veterans Day** – Wednesday, November 11, 2026
- **Thanksgiving Holiday**
 - No mechanical excavation permitted beginning **4:00 pm, Wednesday, November 25, 2026.**
 - Full suspension of all Right of Way activities from **Thursday, November 26, 2026 through 8:00 am on Monday, November 30, 2026**
- **Christmas and New Year's Holidays**
 - No mechanical excavation permitted beginning **4:00 pm, Wednesday, December 23, 2026**
 - Full suspension of all Right of Way activities from **Thursday, December 24, 2026 through 8:00 am on Thursday, January 2, 2027**

SPECIAL EVENTS

- Notices of Right of Way activity suspensions for special events will be issued separately.

REQUIREMENTS DURING SUSPENSIONS

- All equipment and materials must be removed from the clear zone, except items necessary to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

- Emergency and essential work requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis and must be requested by email at least two weeks prior to the holiday or event to:

- In some cases, work during the restricted periods may be formally approved through City of Tampa Contract Administration Department and uploaded into the ROW Permit record in Accela.
