Because the standards require roofing and detailing as defining of the character of a house and its surroundings. The Hyde Park Design Standards state it is permissible to maintain the original roofing

material, is permissible to repair or replace with materials close to the original as possible in size or shape but it is not permissible to replace the roofing with a material that is not characteristic of the building's style.
