Move that the variance request for case BLC-25-0000015 for property located at 2914 N. Nebraska Avenue be granted as depicted on the site plan presented at the Public Hearing for a parking reduction from 23 spaces to 20 spaces, based upon the petitioner meeting the burden of proof with regard to the six hardship criteria set forth in Chapter 27, Section 27-96 (d)) of the City of Tampa Code of Ordinances for granting variances as stated and the evidence provided in this Public Hearing, specifically that it is consistent with the Ybor City Design Guidelines and comprehensive plan for the City of Tampa.

Move that the variance request for case BLC-25-0000015 located at 2914 N. Nebraska Avenue as depicted on the site plan presented at the Public Hearing for a Structure Height Increase from 45'-0" to 48'-6", be granted with the following conditions:

- The open-air trellis area is the only area that is allowed this condition
- The open-air trellis area is not enclosed in the future
- The line of the open-air trellis area for future not be beyond the building envelope outline as depicted on the plans presented

based upon the petitioner meeting the burden of proof with regard to the six hardship criteria set forth in Chapter 27, Section 27-96 (d) of the City of Tampa Code of Ordinances for granting variances

as stated and the evidence provided in this Public Hearing, specifically that the project as presented aligns with the Ybor City Design Guidelines specially to the façade, width, setbacks, alignment, and similarity of details and forms.

FIVE MINUTE RECCESS

Move to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness for the drawings and documents presented at this Public Hearing in BLC-25-000015 for the property located at 2914 N. Nebraska Avenue, with the following conditions:

- The location of the water table at the second and third floor line be reconsidered and distributed to the separation of the first and second floor
- Stucco control joints or expansion joints be developed and defined for all elevations
- Appropriate fencing or buffering elements be added to the Saint Clair elevation to ensure the parking area beneath is screened from view
- Balconies at the rear both on the second and third floor be revisited and reconsidered in terms
 of their size and configuration so that the third floor are more usable
- The windows at the south Saint Clair elevation be revisited and others added or reconfigured to align with the historic context
- The fencing material that is currently wood opaque be reconsidered for either the materiality or its design
- All wall sections be developed in detail thoroughly vetted for all conditions including the storefront, punched openings, balconies, canopies, parapet, and the trellis
- The canopy on the retail ground floor at the corner of Saint Clair and Nebraska be reconsidered to be a continuance canopy so that it turns the corner
- Revisit the location of the building signage to be more forward of the corner in consideration
- Mechanical screening of the units on the rooftop be four sided and all units located appropriately on the roof top

because, based upon the finding of fact, the proposed project is consistent with the Ybor City Design Guidelines of the City of Tampa, for the following reasons, the height and width of the new building are consistent. The setbacks are maintained. The façade elements are in alignment and there is similarity of form.
