- Garage door be more sensitively designed for a historic district;
- Coordinate with staff on the new design on an eyebrow lintel over the side door where the porte-cochere was removed;
- Fencing and gate design to be more carefully designed and not copy the existing fence on the adjacent property;

because, based upon the finding of fact, the proposed project is consistent with the Hyde Park Design Guidelines of the City of Tampa, for the following reasons, it meets Chapter 27 of the City of Tampa Code of Ordinances and meets the Design Guidelines and Secretary of Interior's Standards.
