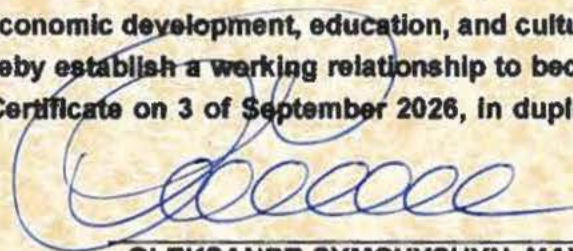
AN AGREEMENT FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF

Khmelnytskyi and Tampa, sharing a common interest in tourism, economic development, education, and culture, and the desire to promote mutual understanding among our cities, do hereby establish a working relationship to become Sister Cities within five (5) years after both cities sign this Friendship Certificate on 3 of September 2026, in duplicate in the Ukrainian and English languages.
