Maintenance activity	Accomplishment	Unit of measure	Description
Paving	0.96; 5.08; 967.1	Lane miles (In-house); lane miles (Contractor); tons of asphalt	In-house and contractor paving projects are selected with coordination of Engineering. Asphalt is removed and paved back.
Potholes (FIF)	201; 17.2	Each; tons of asphalt	Holes in the asphalt exposing the base material underneath.
Edge of Pavement Repair (FIF)	1,802; 7.93	Square feet; tons of asphalt	Edge of pavement repairs are where the asphalt breaks up along the edge and becomes a drop off.
Delaminations (FIF)	3,230; 19.40	Square feet; tons of asphalt	Delaminations are where the asphalt is breaking away exposing the next layer of asphalt but not exposing the base.
Alley Maintenance	0	Square feet	Alley maintenance can include both new asphalt and crushed asphalt.
Asphalt Curb Repair	102	Linear feet	Asphalt curb repairs occur when vehicles run over the curb breaking it up.
Utility Cut Outs for Utility Depts.	48.9	Tons of asphalt	Utility cut out repairs. Approximately 3/4 of a ton per location.




Figure 9. Map of E. Washington St resurfacing project, work order 39761, marked complete, page 13.





Figure 10. Map of Ybor City Safety Project (7th Ave), contractor resurfacing project, work order 43364, page 14.




Figure 13. Orient Rd/7th Ave project map, work order 45265, page 17.




Figure 14. 300 Block S. Tampania curb, gutter, and resurfacing project map, work order 45406, page 18.
