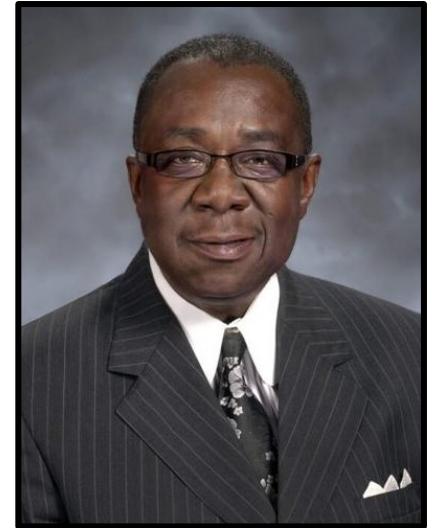

Frank A. Reddick – Honorary Naming

Honoree Background

- Frank Reddick, born November 5, 1955, whose service and leadership were rooted in the East Tampa community.
- Dedicated educator and mentor who served within the Hillsborough County School District and worked with the Florida Department of Corrections to rehabilitate juvenile offenders.



Frank A. Reddick – Honorary Naming

Honoree Background



- President and CEO of the Florida Sickle Cell Association, advancing awareness, care, and support for families impacted by sickle cell disease.
- Served on the Hillsborough County Hospital Authority Board, the East Tampa Partnership, and as president of the Tampa Coalition for Change.
- Served eight years on the Tampa City Council.

Frank A. Reddick – Parks & Recreation Department's Recommendation

- Parks & Recreation Department recommends naming the Williams Park Activity Center the Frank A. Reddick Activity Center.
- Frank A. Reddick meets the criteria for consideration for honorary naming of a Minor City-owned asset per Ordinance 2023-63, Section 2-828 (B)(1), (2), (4), (6), and (7).
