

YARD WASTE: CURB TO COMPOST

Properly prepared yard waste will ensure it gets collected on time and composted.

All Yard Waste Must:



Each containment method must weigh **less than 50 lbs.**

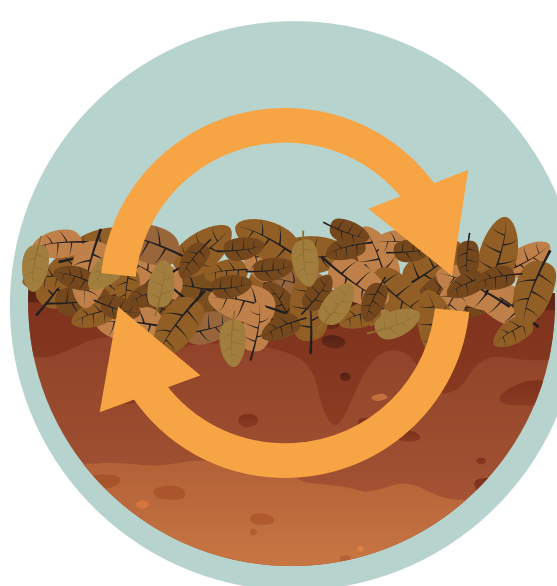


All brush must be cut into **4-foot segments.**



Yard waste must **not exceed 4 cubic yards.**

Looking to reduce your yard work?



Leave the Leaves
Leaves make up 3/4 of the nutrients used by trees annually. Leaving them on the lawn returns nutrients back into the soil.



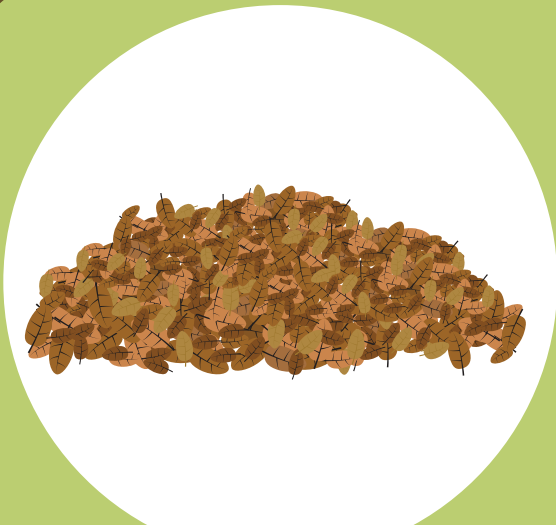
Grasscycling
Don't bag clippings. Grass clippings replenish water and nutrients back into the lawn.



Plant Natives
Reduce water usage costs, conserve natural resources, and preserve habitats for plants and wildlife.

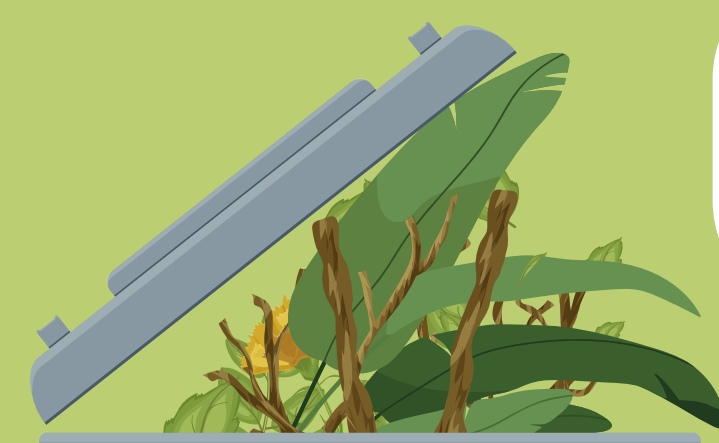
