Nashville: Inclusive Economic Growth

- Creating multiple modes of transportation for the benefit of employees and employers by providing resources and acting as a core advocate at various forums

Atlanta: Reducing Poverty

- Creating opportunity zones within Urban Redevelopment Area (URA) by providing business to invest and create jobs by appropriate amendment in URA plan
- Redefining boundaries of URA by expanding the definition to include social and racial determinants of poverty

Orlando: Economic Diversification

- Investment by city in infrastructure and access
- Investment by city in retraining and skill development
- Focus on investing in civic services

Minneapolis: Improving Median Household Income
