



Mobility Department Parking Plan Update

On October 15th, 2020, City Council approved Resolution No. 2020-722, allowing the Mobility Department to implement its Parking Plan.


The Parking Plan will be implemented in Phases.

1. Phase One will focus on the immediate changes starting in December 2020.
2. Phase Two will focus on Operational changes throughout 2021.
3. Phase Three will focus on long term changes that will begin in 2022.

Additional Notes:

The Mobility Parking Plan was finalized with the collaboration of the Downtown Tampa Parking Plan.

The Parking Plan ensures the Division continues to work with key stakeholders to better serve the community.

Mobility Department Parking Division Background - Initiatives

The Parking Division is responsible for the daily operation of all City public parking, including: 10 City owned parking garages, 13 City owned surface Lots, the City right of way On-Street spaces, & 17 managed surface Lots.

The Division current initiatives include:

- ✓ Converting Poe & TCC garage to Frictionless operation.
- ✓ Upgrading all other garages to a state-of-the-art Parking Management System.
- ✓ Working with the Downtown Partnership on their bike program by adding bike racks to accommodate up to 98 bikes.
- ✓ Introducing a new flex pass for monthly parking - more info will follow.
- ✓ Adding Flex Zones Spaces Citywide - more info will follow.

PHASE ONE DEC -JAN

Monthly Parking, Daily Parking, & Special Events Rates will increase to Year 1 Rates on December 1st, 2020.

Ybor Lot 1, Lot 2, & Lot 3 will convert back to Paid Parking 24/7 on December 15th, 2020.

On-Street Parking Rates will increase to Year 1 Rates on January 1st, 2021.

Standardize On-Street rates & hours of operations for all Downtown area, including implementation of Paid parking North of Kennedy on evenings & weekends.
