

Our Weather & Our Water



Tampa's water conditions change throughout the year. Right now, we are experiencing an extreme drought, with the Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) declaring a Modified Phase III Water Shortage. *See reverse for additional information.*

At the same time, you may see more information about preparing for the upcoming hurricane season. These messages reflect how water in our region naturally varies from season to season.

60% of our annual rainfall occurs during the summer season (June–Sept).

Drought recovery can be slow, but with consistent water conservation efforts, we can help ensure our water resources can meet the needs of today and tomorrow.
