



Temporary Change In Our Water Treatment Process

September 14, 2026 - October 5, 2026

The City of Tampa will temporarily change its water treatment method from chloramine to chlorine disinfection.

This planned, routine maintenance helps maintain water quality throughout our water mains and service lines. It may also reduce the amount of system flushing needed to maintain disinfectant levels, helping conserve water. Your water remains safe to drink and use.

Simple steps that may minimize impact:

- Run the tap for a few minutes.
- Fill a pitcher of water and let it sit for several hours to allow any residual chlorine to dissipate.
- Consider installing a carbon filter on kitchen/bathroom faucets or shower heads.
