WHEREAS, DeMolay International has carried out its goals for over a century through initiatives and programs such as civic involvement, athletic competition, social activity, and charitable projects; and

WHEREAS, in Tampa, Florida, the Paul Revere Chapter of DeMolay is observing its 102nd Anniversary in 2022 and celebrating its position as the first DeMolay Chapter established in the state of Florida, and the occasion provides the opportunity to bring awareness to the community of its many activities, and to recognize the millions of active and senior DeMolays throughout the world.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jane Castor, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the city of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim the month of March 2022 as
