

Proclamation

WHEREAS, Tampa, Florida is a unique and vibrant city with a richly diverse and cultural background, full of magnificent attractions, entertainment venues, museums, festivals, parades, major sporting events, and culinary experiences that make the community a premier destination for visitors, commerce, and conventions; and

WHEREAS, the travel and tourism industry is of tremendous importance to the Tampa Bay area, which vastly contributes to our economic prosperity, employment, international trade and relations, and the visitors to our region contribute greatly to our economy, quality of life, and in creating intercultural understanding and goodwill, and the citizens of Tampa are proud of our uniqueness including world class parks, restaurants, shopping districts, historic Ybor City, Bayshore Boulevard, the Tampa Riverwalk, new Midtown Tampa, developing Water Street Tampa, and more; and

WHEREAS, the Tampa Bay region has become a top destination for travelers from around the world, and the tens of millions of visitors to our community each year contribute to our city's success by generating billions of dollars in spending, and creating over 50,000 jobs through transportation, accommodations, entertainment and historical venues, and the food and beverage industry; and

WHEREAS, *Visit Tampa Bay* plays a primary role in promoting the travel and tourism industry for our region and its mission is to promote the Tampa Bay area as an attractive destination to strengthen its economic position for the community by increasing visitation, and the organization encourages visitors to unlock their inner adventure-seeker through collaboration and partnership with businesses, civic leaders, and the community to tell the story of Tampa Bay including its distinctive history of the cigar industry, Cuban sandwiches, and the world's largest pirate festival, Gasparilla; and

WHEREAS, established in 1983 by a congressional resolution, **National Travel and Tourism Week** (NTTW), is held the first full week in May to celebrate the significance travel holds for the economy, businesses, and personal well-being, and this year, NTTW celebrates with the theme *The Future of Travel*, highlighting the industry's ability to grow and adapt to create a more efficient, sustainable, innovative, and competitive industry, and it is a reminder of how tourism is essential to the city's economic development.
