WHEREAS, a research and teaching hospital and well-known for its educational initiatives, the Tampa VA has 131 affiliations with leading colleges including a 50-year partnership with the University of South Florida College of Medicine, and it provides training for fellows, medical students, residency, nursing, psychology, audiology, social work, dietetics, and pharmacy, and is dedicated to utilizing research to promote optimum health and advanced healthcare; and

WHEREAS, since it was established, the Tampa VA has set the standards for Veteran care, and over the years has been recognized for excellence including receiving many accreditations and as the first VA hospital to earn the American Nurses Credentialing Center's prestigious *Magnet Award*.
