**WHEREAS**, Tampa Hispanic Heritage, Inc. is an organization established in 1979, that is devoted to preserving and promoting Tampa's diverse Hispanic culture, and it has honored individuals who represent excellence by their outstanding achievements, endeavors, and contributions, and who help enrich the lives of other Hispanics; and

**WHEREAS**, Tampa Hispanic Heritage, Inc. will celebrate its 34<sup>th</sup> Annual Hispanic Gala with the presentation of the **2022 Hispanic Man of the Year Award** to a person chosen to be honored, a well-known individual admired and respected for his commitment to others, and who has dedicated his life to promoting and preserving the Hispanic culture and traditions through civic and community service; and

**WHEREAS**, this year's honoree is **Anthony Perez**, who has enriched the lives of others, especially within the Hispanic community throughout his life. **WHEREAS**, Mr. Perez generously contributes his time, energy, and resources to our city and serves in various leadership positions with many nonprofit organizations including the City of Tampa's Mayor's Hispanic Advisory Council where he is a board member and has led as its Chairman, the University of South Florida Latin Community Advisory Committee, he mentors students and advocates for scholarships, contributes to the Judeo Christian Health Clinic, and he founded the nonprofit Covered Hearts that provides for the needs of the less fortunate, including umbrellas for the homeless; and
