

# Proclamation

**WHEREAS**, the American Veterans of the United States Armed Forces have served their country in times of peace and war, and their sacrifices and brave efforts have protected the rights and safety of all American citizens, and they are owed our gratitude and support; and

**WHEREAS**, the veterans of our nation contribute substantially to the prosperity and success of their communities through public service, volunteerism, philanthropic endeavors, and culturally, and they are valued business owners and entrepreneurs who provide a variety of services; and

**WHEREAS**, since 2015, the first week in November has been designated as **National Veterans Small Business Week**, and it provides the opportunity to honor and celebrate the contributions veterans have made and continue to make in America's small business sector and their impact on our nation's economic well-being; and

**WHEREAS**, in the United States, there are approximately 2.4 million businesses owned by veterans of our armed forces that employ 5.8 million people with an annual payroll of \$210 billion, and in the state of Florida, it is reported there are about 187,000 veteran owned firms, and according to the United States Census Bureau, there are over 92,000 veterans residing in Hillsborough County with more than 11,500 of them operating their own businesses, generating an impressive \$5.5 billion in local annual sales; and

**WHEREAS**, the nonprofit Florida Association of Veteran Owned Businesses (FAVOB) is an organization of nearly 400 veteran members and patriotic supporters throughout Florida including the Tampa Chapter, and it advocates, educates, and connects veteran-owned businesses to economic opportunity with a mission that includes promoting and uniting the many established and start-up businesses that are owned by veterans and disabled veterans throughout Florida, and encouraging and helping them successfully grow their companies; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Tampa is pleased to join with the United States Small Business Administration (SBA), the Florida Association of Veteran Owned Businesses, and other supportive organizations in bringing awareness of the vast contributions of veteran-owned businesses in our nation, state, and city.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Jane Castor, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the city of Tampa, Florida, do hereby proclaim October 31 – November 4, 2022, as
